STEPS TO FOLLOW

1. TAKE THE ENGLISH TOLC-I or the TOLC-I in Italian:

Register on <u>www.cisiaonline.it</u> and SIGN UP to the **English TOLC-I** or to the **TOLC-I**. Date and modalities are available at the following web page: https://tolc.cisiaonline.it/calendario.php

SUBMIT an <u>English Language certificate of level B2</u>: in order to register you must present a valid and official certificate of at least level B2. The list of accepted and recognized English Language certificates is stated on the Attachment 1 of this Notice.

2. REGISTER ON STUDENTI ONLINE

Register on Studenti Online (SOL) (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) logging in with your SPID or CIE credentials. The system will automatically retrieve your data and upon completion will create your University credentials (<u>name.surname@studio.unibo.it</u>).

If you are an **underage student** or an **international student** without an identity document issued in Italy, you must apply for University credentials. To obtain them go to **Studenti OnLine (SOL)** (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) and click on "Register". Once you have obtained the credentials, you will be able to register on Studenti Online.

3. UPLOAD THE DOCUMENTS ON SOL NO LATER THAN 13/11/2024

Click on "Admission request", select "Requirements verification for Building construction Engineering" and upload:

> STAGE 1

- a. A valid English language certificate B2 level (3 years);
- **b.** A valid copy of an identification document (ID, passport, driving license);

<u>If you are an international student</u> and you have achieved a **High School Diploma abroad**, <u>you must also upload</u>:

> STAGE 2

- c. A copy of your **High School Diploma in PDF** format;
- d. DECLARATION OF VALUE (DOV) of your educational qualification: attesting that your qualification has been achieved after 12 years of schooling. For more information: https://www.unibo.it/en/study/enrolment-fees-and-other-procedures/degree-programme-foreign-qualification
- **e. LEGALIZATION of your educational qualification:** to be accepted in Italy your Diploma must be translated and legalized. For more information: https://www.unibo.it/en/study/enrolment-fees-and-other-procedures/degree-programmes/enrolling-in-first-or-single-cycle-degree-programme-foreign-qualification

f. Copy of RESIDENCE PERMIT, if owned.

NOTICE: any requests of change or integration of documents will be communicated on your SOL profile. Check constantly your request and the field NOTES.

4. ENROLMENT

When the STAGE 1 explained in the paragraph 3 will be completed with all the documents requested, you will be able to proceed with the enrolment to the degree course by the due deadlines: **September 26, 2024** or **November 21, 2024 with a late submission fee**.

After November 21, 2024 it will no longer be possible to enroll to the academic year 2024/2025.

How you can enrol:

- f. Go on Studenti Online (SOL) (www.studenti.unibo.it)
- g. Select "Bachelors' Degree" "Building construction Engineering"
- h. Fill in the form and pay the first instalment: to make the enrolment effective, together with the filling of the form you must proceed with the payment of the first instalment within the due deadlines.
- i. If you are an international student, you must also upload on Studenti OnLine (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) in the section "Call" the documents concerning your educational qualification choosing "Matriculation for the 24_25 academic year - document upload for international students with foreign qualifications"
- j. You have to upload here the documents relating to your foreign qualification, passport, ID and if any visa or residence permit. Once you will be arrived in Italy, you must book an appointment with the Student Administration Office writing an e-mail to segravenna@unibo.it to submit your documents in original.

NOTICE: The admitted applicants must make sure that their educational qualification is in accordance with the requirements which allow the access to the Italian University system. If your Diploma does not make you eligible for the Italian University system, you will not be able to proceed with matriculation in any way.

> CHANGING AND TRANSFERRING

If you are intended to change degree or transfer to the course, you must follow the steps outlined above: take the TOLC-I or English TOLC-I test and register on **Studenti Online SOL**.

NOTICE: Both TOLC@Home and TOLC-I in presence took from 1st January 2023 are considered valid. If you have taken more than one test, the system will automatically upload the score of the last one.

5. CHECK THE OFA (Additional Learning Requirement)

OFA is an Additional Learning Requirement which all the Italian Universities must verify. You will be assigned an OFA if you get less than **12/20** in **Mathematics section** of the English TOLC-I or TOLC-I.

You must fulfill the OFA by the March 31, 2026 according to the modalities defined by the degree course.

If you do not pass the OFA by the deadline of **March 31, 2026**, you will be registered **as repeater of the first year.**
