Prof. Anastasios Xepapadeas



Anastasios Xepapadeas is an environmental and resource economist recognized internationally for his work on environmental policy and resource management and, more specifically, on issues related to the management of pollution, the interaction of environmental and industrial policies, the relationship between environment and growth, the valuation of biodiversity, and the design of policies for ecosystem management and climate change under deep uncertainty.

Xepapadeas was born and grew up in Piraeus, Greece. He graduated from the University of Athens with a degree in Economics, and from the University of Manchester, England with an MA degree (1977) and a PhD degree (1981) in Economics. He has served as president of the European Association of Environmental and Resources Economists and chairman of the Board of the Beijer Institute of the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences. He is currently a Professor at Athens University of Economics and Business in Greece and at the University of Bologna in Italy. He is also an elected international member of the US National Academy of Sciences.

He has published more than one hundred and fifty scientific papers in leading academic journals and collective volumes. He has editorial positions in the academic journals *Environmental and Resource Economics* and *Annual Review of Resource Economics*.

He has received research funds as coordinator or lead researcher for more than 35 research projects from a variety of prestigious institutions.
