Introducing *Tomorrow's Europe*: A new podcast series from Euranet Plus

Europe, once synonymous with stability, is now rife with uncertainty. The very principles on which the continent was built are being called into question by the rise of far-right movements. A shifting geopolitical landscape is rewriting long-held alliances. Artificial intelligence is redefining the way we work and reshaping entire industries. Meanwhile, Europe itself appears mired in internal disputes and more vulnerable than ever.

But is this a moment of dissolution – or reinvention? How could Europe seize the challenges of the moment as opportunities to redirect? What would it look like to move into a brighter future with clarity and unity?

“Tomorrow’s Europe”, a new podcast series from the pan-European Euranet Plus network, takes on these urgent questions. With reporters stretching from Portugal to Bulgaria, Estonia to Greece, the series brings first-hand expertise and in-depth analysis to answer the question of how the continent can best navigate the changing global tides.

The 12-episode journey begins with one of the most pressing issues of our time: can Europe defend itself from external aggression? From there, we’ll explore Europe’s potential for achieving energy independence; the Xs and Os of its diplomatic tactics and strategies; and make predictions about Europe’s long-range future: *Will all Europeans one day speak the same language? What will Europe look like in the face of irreversible climate change? Could we potentially defend ourselves against a foreign threat without the help of the US?*

The series is hosted by Hermine Donceel, a seasoned journalist specialising in EU affairs and editor-in-chief of Euranet Plus. She will be joined by leading experts and journalists from across the continent, making complex issues both accessible and compelling.

“Europe is at a crossroads. Our goal with Tomorrow’s Europe is to look beyond the noise of daily politics and examine the deeper forces shaping the continent’s future,” says Hermine Donceel. “By bringing together voices from across Europe, we hope to give listeners both clarity and perspective in a time of uncertainty.”

Tomorrow’s Europe has freshly premiered and will continue throughout the coming months. Episodes will be available on major podcast platforms as well as on the radio waves of Euranet Plus member stations.
