1. ADMISSION REQUISITES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

To be admitted in the Genomics Degree Programme you need to apply to the specific intake.

There are two ordinary intakes: you need to apply according to the schedule appointed in the [General Calendar](#).

The **first intake** (May) is addressed to **non-EU candidates living outside Italy (12 positions) and Italian, EU and EU assimilated candidates (24 positions): access through English TOLC-I.**

The **second intake** (July) is addressed to **Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates (24 positions + positions left from previous selection): access through TOLC-I in Italian.**

For each selection you can express your interest in **open positions (see paragraph 3.2).**

To apply, you need to possess the specific requisites specified in Paragraph 1.2 (Admission Requisites).

The Degree Programme is in English. A B2 level (or higher) in English is required for the admission (see Paragraph 1.2 “Admission Requisites”).

If you are currently enrolled at the University of Bologna or another University, you have a previous University Career you need to apply to the intake according to the provisions of this call.

1.1. EXTRAORDINARY INTAKE

Should there be available positions left after the two intakes, an extraordinary intake is activated. It will be addressed to Italian, EU and non-EU candidates (access through TOLC-I in Italian). The specific information will be published on the Degree Programme Website.

1.2. Admission Requisites

To be admitted to the intake and eventually enrol, you need to:

- hold one of the following **qualifications**:
 - Five-year Secondary School Diploma (including the Italian Schools with extra year). It is possible to apply to the intake and eventually enrol even if the diploma has not been obtained yet: in this case it should be obtained before **30th December 2024**, or otherwise the enrolment will no longer be valid.
 - Experimental Four-year Secondary School Diploma, issued by the authorized schools foreseen by the National Plan of Four-year Secondary School.
 - Four-year secondary school diploma with extra year. In this case you will be given an extra additional learning requirement that must be fulfilled before 31st March 2026: if you fail at fulfilling it, you will be registered as a repeater of the first year.
 - Foreign secondary school diploma, which was obtained following **at least 12 years of schooling** and allows the enrolment in Universities in the country where it was issued, according to the rules set by our Ministry of University and Research for the A.Y. 2024/2025 that are published here: <http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/>

- **Take the English TOLC-I or the TOLC-I in Italian test (according to the intake you apply to)**, managed by CISIA, before the deadlines set in the [General Calendar](#). Registrations to the English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian tests must be done on the CISIA Website: www.cisiaonline.it.
Please check carefully your data (name, surname, date and place of birth) as they must match those registered on Studenti Online.
 - Take the **English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian test before the deadline** set in the [General Calendar](#) (point 1). The Student Administration Office will get your scores automatically from CISIA.
If you register for the intake without taking the TOLC test before the deadline or having taken a TOLC test different from the one accepted, you will be excluded from the ranking;
 - **We accept TOLC tests taken from 1st January 2023, as explained below:**
 - TOLC tests held in person (TOLC@UNI) during 2023
 - TOLC tests held in person (TOLC@UNI) during 2024
 - TOLC@HOME tests held during 2023
 - TOLC@HOME tests held during 2024 only for non-EU students with residency abroad

- check carefully your data (name, surname, date and place of birth) as they must match those registered on Studenti Online, so that the University of Bologna offices can get the English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian associated to your application;
 - English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian **per se** is not sufficient for the purpose of this selection: you also need to apply on Studenti Online, following the instructions in Section 2 “APPLICATION”;
 - At the following webpage: www.unibo.it/TOLC you can find general information on the use of TOLC tests by the University of Bologna. If you are a student with disabilities or specific learning disabilities (DSA), please check the information in [Attachment 1](#).
- **Have a B2 (or higher) English Language Certificate**, before the deadline of the registrations to each intake (see [General Calendar](#)).

For the purpose of this selection, we will accept the certificates listed in the specific Chart ([Tabella certificazioni equipollenti prova idoneita linguistica](#)) available in the University of Bologna Linguistic Centre (CLA) website <https://centri.unibo.it/cla/it/riconoscimento-idoneita-linguistica>, if issued from **1st January 2021**.

N. B.: the certificate must be uploaded on Studenti Online www.studenti.unibo.it before the deadline of the registrations to each intake (**see [General Calendar](#)**) according to the modalities specified in paragraphs 2.1 and 2.2, otherwise you’ll be left out of the selections.

This requisite is considered as satisfied in case students have an International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, a High School Diploma or a General Certificate of Education (GCE), all obtained in English.

If you sit an English Language Certificate examination (among the ones accepted) and got a B2 (or higher) level, but you have not the certificate by the deadline of the registration to the intake, you can upload an **official document** that certifies that you have taken the test and its relative results (e.g. Statement of Results) or you’ll be left out of the selection.

Nevertheless, if you are entitled with a position and eventually enrol in the Programme, you need to send your official certificate to this address farbiomot.genomics@unibo.it from your institutional e-mail address (name.surname@studio.unibo.it) **before the deadline of the enrolment** (see [General Calendar](#)), **otherwise your enrolment will no longer be valid**.

1.3. Available Positions

In Academic Year 2024/2025 there will be **60 available positions**, divided as follows:

- **First intake: 12 positions addressed to non-EU candidates living outside of Italy & 24 positions addressed to Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates;**
- **Second intake: 24 positions addressed to Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates.**

Should places reserved to non-EU citizens living outside of Italy be not fully covered, more positions will be available for Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates. Should places reserved to Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates be not fully covered in the first intake, they will be available in the second intake for Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates.

2. APPLICATION

- If you are a **non-EU citizen living outside of Italy** you can apply in the **first intake only**. See **Paragraph 2.1**.
- If you are an **Italian, EU or EU assimilated citizen** you can apply in the **first and second intake**. See **Paragraph 2.2**.

2.1 Non-EU Citizens living outside of Italy

If you are a **non-EU citizen living outside of Italy** you can apply in the **first intake only** according to the schedule specified in the [General Calendar](#). In this intake, access to the Programme is through English TOLC-I.

- **Access Studenti Online** (www.studenti.unibo.it) click on “Registri” and then “Registrazione studenti internazionali” (you may then switch to English by clicking on the top left button). The Unibo Credentials that will be created are valid throughout the whole academic career and are required to access all online services at Unibo.

Please make sure you insert all your data carefully (use the format: day/month/year). Your data must match those on the CISIA Website (www.cisiaonline.it) in order to get your tests results correctly.

- **Register to the intake**
 - Click on “Entrance exams or requirements check”
 - Select “First cycle degree programme”
 - Select “Genomics”
- **Upload the following documents in PDF format on Studenti Online** www.studenti.unibo.it:
 - Copy of your valid passport. The document must clearly show the expiry date;
 - English Language Certificate, B2 level or higher.

- **Check that the all the required documents are uploaded correctly**

- **Pay the required fee**

Pay the 20€ required fee according to the modalities you’ll find on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), which is not refundable. If you do not pay the fee within the deadline set in the [General Calendar](#), your registration will not be valid.

- **Check the list of candidates whose English TOLC-I was not received by the University of Bologna on Studenti Online** (www.studenti.unibo.it).

On the date appointed in point 2a in the [General Calendar](#), check the list of candidates whose English TOLC-I was not received by the University of Bologna on Studenti Online – Section “Requests in Progress” (www.studenti.unibo.it).

If your name is in this list, you need to send an e-mail (Object: ATTESTATO TOLC, Genomics) with the following documents within the set deadline (see [General Calendar](#)) to the Student Administration Office of Pharmacy Biotechnology and Sport Science (segfarbiomot@unibo.it):

- **The certificate** of the last English TOLC-I test taken (it must include your Fiscal Code and the date when you took the English TOLC-I test);
- A copy of your **valid passport**.

2.1. Italian, EU and EU-assimilated citizens

If you are an **Italian, EU and EU-assimilated citizen** you can apply in the **first and in the intake** according to the schedule specified in the [General Calendar](#). In the first intake, access to the Programme is through English TOLC-I while in the second intake through TOLC-I in Italian.

- **Access Studenti Online** (www.studenti.unibo.it) according to the modality based on you own case:
 - **use SPID or CIE Credentials**. The system will automatically get your Data and will create your credentials as name.surname@studio.unibo.it;
 - **if you are a minor without SPID** go to www.studenti.unibo.it and choose “Registrati” (you may then switch to English by clicking on the top left button). The Unibo Credentials (name.surname@studio.unibo.it) that will be created are valid throughout the whole academic career and are required to access all online services at Unibo.
 - **if you are an international student** and you do not have and ID Document issued in Italy, go to www.studenti.unibo.it and choose “Registrati” (you may then switch to English by clicking on the top left button). The Unibo Credentials (name.surname@studio.unibo.it) that will be created are valid throughout the whole academic career and are required to access all online services at Unibo.

Please make sure you insert all your data carefully (use the format: day/month/year). Your data must match those on the CISIA Website (www.cisiaonline.it) in order to get your tests results correctly.

- **Register to the intake**
 - Click on “Entrance exams or requirements check”
 - Select “First cycle degree programme”
 - Select “Genomics”
- **Upload the following documents in PDF format on Studenti Online www.studenti.unibo.it:**
 - Copy of your valid ID (both sides) or valid passport. The document must clearly show the expiry date. If you do not hold an Italian ID document, you must upload your valid passport;
 - English Language Certificate, B2 level or higher;
 - *Mandatory for EU-assimilated candidates:* Copy of your valid Italian Residence Permit or copy of the request of renewal. Only some Residence Permits (issued by the Italian Government) entitle citizens to be EU-assimilated. - **Check that all the required documents are uploaded correctly**
- **Pay the required fee**

Pay the 20€ required fee according to the modalities you’ll find on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), which is not refundable. If you do not pay the fee within the deadline set in the [General Calendar](#), your registration will not be valid.
- **Check the list of candidates whose English TOLC-I (in the first intake) and TOLC-I in Italian (in the second intake) was not received by the University of Bologna on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it).**

On the date appointed in point 2a in the [General Calendar](#), check the list of candidates whose English TOLC-I (in the first intake) and TOLC-I in Italian (in the second intake) was not received by the University of Bologna on Studenti Online – Section “Requests in Progress” (www.studenti.unibo.it).

If you are a non-EU citizen with a residence permit for study purposes and withdraw from a Degree Programme of this or another University, you lose your right to stay in Italy and your residence permit is therefore cancelled. You must enrol again and go back to your Country in order to start the pre-enrolment procedure via the Italian Embassy/Consulate and through www.universitaly.it, within the deadlines yearly defined: <http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/>.

3. RANKING AND OPEN POSITIONS

For each intake there will be a specific ranking based on the points attained, from the highest score to the lowest.

The threshold to access the programme is a score equal to or higher than 15 out of 50 in the whole English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian Score.

The ranking is published on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), in the “Requests in Progress” Section. Rankings will not be published otherwise.

Rankings will be published according to the schedule available in the [General Calendar](#).

3.1. Ranking Criteria

At the end of each intake, an appointed Board will evaluate the applications received by making sure that applicants have the requisites specified in Paragraph 1.1. The Board will draw the ranking on the basis of the last English TOLC-I/last TOLC-I in Italian score taken by candidates before the deadlines set in the [General Calendar](#).

In case of a tie, these will be the prevailing conditions in order of importance:

- The candidate with the highest score in the Maths Section of the English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian test;
- The youngest candidate.

The threshold to access the programme is a score equal to or higher than 15 out of 50 in the whole English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian Score.

If you are entitled with a position (*vincitore*) or eventually given an open position, you can enrol.

You will be assigned an OFA (standing for *Obbligo Formativo Aggiuntivo*, i.e. Additional Learning Requirement) if you scored less than 12 out of 20 in the “Math” Section of the English TOLC-I/TOLC-I in Italian test.

OFA must be fulfilled before 31st March 2026. More information can be found in the Teaching Regulation of the Degree Programme and on the website:

When the ranking is published, you will be marked as one of the following:

- **VINCITORE** - You obtained a score that allows you to enrol in the Degree Programme because your position in the ranking is amongst the available positions for the specific intake. You must enrol according to the deadlines and the instructions you can find in the [General Calendar](#), otherwise you'll be left out of the selection.
- **IDONEO** - You obtained a score that does not allow you to enrol in the Degree Programme because your position in the ranking is not amongst the available positions for the specific round of admissions.

You may ask to be included in the programme by confirming your interest in the open positions, according to the instructions in paragraph 3.2.

- **NON IDONEO** – You are left out of the selection because you scored less than 15/50 in the TOLC test, even if there are available positions.

3.2. Open Positions

Open positions will be available only if candidates marked as “VINCITORE” do not enrol eventually.

The schedule is available in the [General Calendar](#) and you must stick to the deadlines, otherwise you'll be left out of the selection.

This is not an automatic procedure, if you do not express your interest in open positions you will be left out of the selection!

A list of newly admitted candidates will be published on www.studenti.unibo.it, inside your application and within the specific deadline available in the [General Calendar](#).

3.2.1. Expressing your interest in open positions

If you are marked as **IDONEO** in the ranking, and you want to apply for open positions, you can express your interest according to the following procedure:

1. Go to www.studenti.unibo.it, through the dedicated button inside your application and within the specific deadline;
2. Express your interest in open positions, through the dedicated button in your application (“Requests in Progress” Section);
3. Verify your request on Studenti Online. The system will show you the date of your request and it will be possible to download a proof of the request.

4. ENROLMENT

If you are entitled with a position (*vincitore*) you can enroll according to the Schedule you can find in the [General Calendar](#).

- **If you are enrolling for the first time**, see paragraph 4.1;
 - **If you are still a minor** (i.e. you are less than 18 years old) while enrolling please download the form available at this [webpage \(Parental Responsibility\)](#) and send it filled in and signed by your parents to the Student Administration Office – Pharmacy, Biotechnology and Sport Science: segarbiomot@unibo.it;
- **If you are transferring from another University or from another Degree Programme of the University of Bologna**, see paragraph 4.2 and 4.3;
- **If you are requesting for the recognition of previous University career(s)**: after enrolling and **before 28th November 2024** you must check the information available here: <https://www.unibo.it/en/teaching/enrolment-transfer-and-final-examination/shortening-of-the-degree-programme>.

Information on **fees and study grants** are available in paragraph 4.4.

4.1. First Ever Enrolment to the University of Bologna

Within the deadlines set in the [General Calendar](#), you must:

- **Access Studenti Online** (www.studenti.unibo.it), via SPID or with your institutional personal username and password;
- **select “Registration” > “First-cycle degree programme (new degree system)” > “Genomics” and insert** the requested information and upload a JPG file of your passport-size photo (beware of the consequences under art. 496 of Italian Criminal Code regarding false declarations: in such case, you are punishable by law, will be not enrolled, and will lose any right to benefits or reimbursements);
- **Pay** the first instalment – or the total amount – of Genomics tuition fees. Payment modes other than those indicated on Studenti Online will not be accepted. If you do not pay within the set deadline you are left out of the selection, late payments will not be accepted.
- **Activate your career:**
 - If you enrolled via **SPID or CIE** and you do not fall into one of the situations listed in points a) and c) below, after paying the fee your university career will be automatically activated;
 - If you enrolled via your **username and password**: check the specific info you’ll find on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it)

You must activate your career and finalize your enrolment before 28th February 2025, otherwise you’ll lose the right to enrol in A.Y. 2024/2025.

Once your career is activated you can access Unibo services, such as study plans submission, exams booking, Wi-Fi, online libraries: you will also receive an e-mail to print your Badge, according to the modalities that will be specified within.

If you do not activate you career you cannot use Unibo services!

In the following cases there are specific information on enrolment:

- If you are a EU-assimilated student with a qualification obtained in Italy**, you have to send the copy of your residence permit to the Student Administration Office (segfarbiomot@unibo.it);
- If you are a non-EU student living outside of Italy**: you need to [check the specific info](#), access Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), select “Calls” and then “Document Upload for International Students with Foreign Qualifications”: also upload a copy of your residence permit or the copy of the receipt, attesting the request has been forwarded (in this case, your enrolment will be considered as conditional until the actual residence permit can be shown);
- If you have a foreign qualification**. You must check the information available [here](#), access Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it), select “Calls” and then “Document Upload for International Students with Foreign Qualifications”: then upload the documents related to your qualification before 28th February 2025. Afterwards, once you are in Italy, you’ll need to book an appointment with the International Student Administration Office to show the hardcopy of your qualification.

4.2 Candidates transferring from other Universities

Within the deadlines set in the [General Calendar](#) you must:

- **Access Studenti Online** (www.studenti.unibo.it);
- **select “Registration” > “First-cycle degree programme (new degree system)” > “Genomics” and insert the requested information and upload a JPG file of your passport-size photo (beware of the consequences under art. 496 of Italian Criminal Code regarding false declarations: in such case, you are punishable by law, will be not enrolled, and will lose any right to benefits or reimbursements);**
- **Pay the first instalment – or the total amount – of Genomics tuition fees.** Payment modes other than those indicated on Studenti Online will not be accepted. If you do not pay within the set deadline you are left out of the selection, late payments will not be accepted.
- **Hand in your transfer request to your belonging University,** according to their deadlines.

Your career at Unibo will be activated only after the recognition of your transfer by the Programme Board.

4.3 Candidates enrolled in another Degree Programme of the University of Bologna (*Passaggi*)

If you are currently enrolled in a Degree Programme of the University of Bologna, within the deadlines set in the [General Calendar](#) you must:

- **Access Studenti Online** (www.studenti.unibo.it);
- **Pay the first instalment or the total amount of the fees of the programme in which you are currently enrolled for the new academic year** and be ok with your fee record;
- **Fill in the specific transfer request (*passaggio di corso*)** on Studenti Online www.studenti.unibo.it and pay the transfer fee.

You will be able to take exams in the former degree programme until you send your transfer request (*passaggio di corso*), while you will have your career on the new programme activated only after the Programme Board approves your transfer.

N.B.: according to the Degree Programme Teaching Regulations only units taken in English may be recognized.

4.4 Fees and Study Grants

Fees are recalculated according to family income as it results from a valid ISEE that must be uploaded within specific deadlines.

You need to have a valid B2 English Language Certificate among the ones accepted.

Upload your Certificate on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it) before the set deadline.

3. REGISTER ON STUDENTI ONLINE AND APPLY TO GENOMICS

Apply by accessing Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it):

- Click on “Entrance exams and Requirements check”;
- Choose “**Genomics**”;
- Upload all the required documents in .pdf format;
- Pay the 20€ fee.

N.B.! Make sure you apply in the intake dedicated to the group of students to which you belong.

4. CHECK THE RANKING

The ranking will be published on Studenti Online (www.studenti.unibo.it) according to the schedule available in the [General Calendar](#).

5. ENROL

If you are marked as VINCITORE in the ranking, or after the round of open positions, enrol within the set deadline and according to the procedure explained in section 4 of this Call for Applications.

Remember that if you fail to pay the first instalment of Genomics Fee you'll be left out of the selection.

ATTACHMENT 1 – TOLC TESTS ADAPTATIONS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AND SPECIFIC LEARNING DISABILITIES (DSA)

If you are a student with special needs or learning disabilities and want to request adaptations to be made for the TOLC test, you must select this option when registering to the TOLC section of the CISIA portal. (www.cisiaonline.it) In the email confirming your registration, you will find a link to a form where you must specify the University you are applying to, your special needs or learning disabilities, the type of support required and an area where you can upload the necessary documents. Afterwards, you'll be able to specify where you'll take the English TOLC-I test.

If you choose to take the TOLC test at the University of Bologna, you may:

- Have 30% more time if you have a learning disability, 50% more time if you are disabled (Law 104)
- Have the possibility to use specific tools, such as non-scientific calculators.

Disabled candidates living outside of Italy must upload the legalized certificate of their Disability Status, together with an official translation either in Italian or English.
