MODALITIES AND DEADLINE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE STUDY PLANS A.Y. 2025/2026

Periods of submission:

- **1° period: from 23 September to 20 November 2025**
- **2° period: from 12 February 2026 to 6 March 2026**
- **3° period: from 14 to 29 May 2026**

In the “Linguistic group” you have to choose one of the languages listed and the same language has to be chosen the second year.

In the first year, it is not possible neither to add a course of the group “**COMPETENZE LINGUISTICHE-PROGETTO CAMPUS**” nor to anticipate courses of the second year.

WORKSHOP

Each WORKSHOP has a **maximum number of participant students (40 students)**. To attend the lectures, the workshop has to be selected in the study plan.

It is not possible to select a workshop in which the maximum number of students has already been reached. Hence, it is recommended also to change the study plan promptly in case you choose to attend a course different from the one you selected.

Compulsory attendance: all the workshops require compulsory attendance (at least 70% of the scheduled hours) .

I will spend a period of study abroad (Erasmus, Overseas...), do I have to submit the study plan?

Yes, the study plan must be presented according to the modality and the deadlines scheduled, even when the student is planning to spend a study period abroad. After returning from the period of study abroad, the student is not required to submit the paper version of the study plan because the possible modifications * will be made directly by the Segreteria Studenti, after having received the deliberation of recognition.

What is the individual study plan?

The individual study plan is the instrument that allows you to modify the didactic plan defined by the Degree Course, as long as the modifications respect the rules established in the Didactic Organization. It has to be submitted to the Programme Coordinator together with the revenue stamp (€ 16,00) and the motivation letter addressed to the Coordinator of the Study Course. The approval of the individual study plan competes to the Council of the Degree Course. The council, seen the motivation presented by the student, evaluates the study plan on the basis of the coherence with the

Didactic organization and with the educational objectives of the study course and verifies that the number of exams, of courses and related CFU is not less than the correspondent number on the official study plan.

EXTRA CREDITS

The Degree programme council on the 14 May 2025 has established that students can choose **maximum 30 extra credits** within the Group of elective courses (TAF D).

The exams giving extra credits included in the study plan and passed with a positive grade contribute to the final average grade of the graduation.

If you choose courses as extra credits but you do not take the exams, these courses will be eliminated automatically by the Segreteria Studenti during the verification of the study plan conducted before the graduation (the office performs the elimination after the deadline of the presentation of the requisites to graduate).

1st YEAR STUDENTS (matriculated 25-26 cod. 6651)

Have to submit the study plan online to choose one language course

2nd YEAR STUDENTS (matriculated 24-25 cod. 8048)

Have to submit the study plan online to choose:

- **The language course of the second year** (the same language as the one taken in the first year)
- **The workshop**

3rd YEAR STUDENTS (matriculated 23-24 cod. 8048)

Have to submit the study plan online to choose:

- One course in the **“Group of choice in Area studies”**
- The courses in the **“Group of elective courses”**

NEW SELECTION OF CURRICULAR INTERNSHIP

During the three periods of submission of the study plan, students enrolled in the third year **can select 1 INTERNSHIP (10 cfu =250 hours)** among the list of activities of the group “elective courses” TAF-D .

Students are invited to select **also two elective courses** in addition to the Internship. When the Internship will be completed and registered, one of these two courses will be an extra activity and the Student Secretary will eliminate it automatically from the stud plan if the exam has not been taken.
