Call for the award of 4 study grants for students registering in First Cycle Degree Programme Economics of Tourism – Curriculum in International Tourism and Leisure Industries At the School of Economics, Management and Statistics – Rimini Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna, FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18

This English version of the call is made only for publicity purposes. For enforcing the call, resolving any dispute and for all legal purposes only the Italian version is valid.

ART. 1 - Subject, amount and duration

In order to promote the enrolment of students in the degree programme Economics of Tourism – curriculum International Tourism and Leisure Industries, the School of Economis, Management and Statistics has funded 4 study grants for the amount of € 2.000 (gross of all charges for the beneficiary's account), for students registering for A.Y. 2017-18 to the above mentioned degree programme, divided as follows:

- 2 study grants for European students (Italian, European and equivalent status citizens), subdivided equally in intake A and intake B;

- 2 study grants for international students (NON EU citizens), subdivided equally in intake A and intake B; International students are all those whose qualifications for admission to the chosen degree programme were obtained in an institution outside of the Italian education system, in spite of the citizenship. If the number of suitable candidates does not cover the available grants on in intake A, the remaining grants will be allocated to candidates of the intake B.

If the number of suitable candidates in intake B does not cover the available grants on one level, the remaining grants will be allocated to candidates of the other level.

By registering is meant the first enrolment to the first year in the degree programmes. Enrolling in years following the first year, transferring from a degree programme to another or from a university to another, is not considered registering (art. 3, 13, 14 of the Regolamento Studenti, D.R. 464/2013). Each study grant is awarded for one academic year only. The potential renewal of the grant may only be possible through a specific call for applications and according to the following requirements based on merit: nr 50 CFU with a GPA of 26/30, to be acquired by 30/09/2018.

ART. 2 –Incompatibility

These study grants are not cumulative with study grants/prizes issued by the University of Bologna for the same purpose (including the study grants Unibo action 2 and Unibo for Refugees), study grants issued under the Erasmus Mundus Action 1 (now EMJMD), study grants issued by the Regional Board for the Right to Higher Studies (ER.GO), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI), the Collegio Superiore in Bologna, with CRUI grants for beneficiaries of international protection (considering the budget for meals). The study grants are compatible with other forms of study support funded by ER.GO (such as fee exemption, housing services, etc.).

ART. 3 – Admission requirements to the assignment of the grant.

For the participation to this call, the candidate is required to possess the requirements expected under art. 2 of the act PD n. 451 date 06/02/2017 for the admission to the degree programme in Economics of Tourism - curriculum International Tourism and Leisure Industries.

ART. 4 Assignement criteria

The grants will be assigned by the appointed Committee in charge of the evaluation for the admission procedures, based on the same ranking list and will be granted after finalizing the enrolment prcess as stated in art. 8 below.

The grants will be assigned to applicant of this present call and who will be accepted with a minimum score of 80/100.

ART. 5 – Application procedure: terms and conditions

Send the application form A according to the following deadline:

- 1. 9 April 2017 time 12.00 (CET) for candidates of the intake A
- 2. 8 June 2017 time 12.00 (CET), for candidates of the intake B

Later applications will not be considered, as well as incomplete application forms.

ART. 7 - Acceptance.

Winners will be notified of the award of the study grant by e-mail. No later than 10 days from the date of receipt of notice of award of the study grant, in order to confirm the acceptance assignees must send an e-mail to <u>cdl.itali@unibo.it</u>, under penalty of loss of the grant. Assignees must state their full acceptance without reserve of the study grant, at the conditions laid down in the call for applications. In this statement, they must provide express confirmation, under their own full responsibility, that they do not fall within any of the conditions of incompatibility laid down in article 2 of this call for applications. They shall also commit to notify the university of any variation in the declared information which may arise during the year.

ART. 8 – Method of payment of the study grant

The payment of the grant is subject to the effective admission and registration of the student in the degree programme, and it is also subject to the delivery of the specific forms, duly filled in, to the Administrative Students office.

As for international students, in order to be admitted and to register, the student must comply with the provisions and deadlines in force, including the regulations laid down for enrolment in the Circular Letter of the Ministry of Education, University and Research concerning the access of foreign students to university degree programmes.

Payments will be available after finalization of above mentioned procedure.

Payment of the study grants is made by bank transfer to the Italian current account or prepaid credit card with Italian IBAN registered or co-registered to the student-beneficiary.

ART. 9 – Withdrawal

Applicants may withdraw by sending an e-mail to <u>cdl.itali@unibo.it</u>. In case of withdrawals received by 15 September 2017, the grants will be allocated to the next suitable candidates in the same list of applicants. Transfer to a different degree programme for the academic year 2017/2018, is equivalent to withdrawal and the candidate will be required to reimburse the full amount.

ART. 10 – Information notice concerning data processing

The Administration reserves the right to verify the truth of the information provided. Without prejudice to the penal sanctions laid down in article 76 of Italian Decree of the President of the Republic no. 445/2000, in the event of fraudulent information being discovered as a result of such verification, the applicant will forfeit the right to the study grant.
