CALL FOR APPLICATIONS ITALIAN ERASMUS PROGRAM

a.a. $2025/26 - 2^{\circ}$ semester

The "Italian Erasmus" program promotes interdisciplinary and flexible study paths by encouraging student mobility between Italian universities.

Mobility periods range from 3 to 6 months and are based on agreements between universities, allowing students enrolled in bachelor's, master's, or single-cycle degree programs to participate in innovative academic exchanges.

A specific agreement is being finalized between the University of Bologna and the University of Naples Federico II, valid for two academic years starting in 2025/26. Positions offered under this agreement are conditional to the finalization of such agreement.

This call aims to select Advanced Cosmetic Sciences students interested in a mobility period at the University of Naples Federico II.

Selected students will remain enrolled at their home university and will not pay additional fees to the host institution, where they will have access to available services. Financial support will be provided by the home university to help cover extra costs related to living in another city.

Activities and Eligibility – Italian Erasmus Program

What activities are allowed?

Under the agreements between universities, students may engage in **final thesis preparation** activities.

Before departure, participants must draft a Learning Agreement outlining their study plan and activities during the exchange. This agreement must include a minimum of 6 ECTS credits (CFU), proportionate to the mobility duration, and be approved by the relevant academic body.

At the end of the mobility, the host university will issue documentation of completed activities and earned credits, which students can request to be recognized by their home institution.

Admission Requirements

To be eligible candidates must be enrolled in the second-cycle degree program in Advanced Cosmetic Sciences (code 9225).

Enrollment must be maintained throughout the selection process. Selected students must renew their enrollment at the University of Bologna for the 2025/26 academic year by the official deadlines. Graduation is not permitted before completing the mobility period and the formal recognition of activities by the academic board.

Mobility Period and Duration

Mobility must last between 3 and 6 consecutive months. Extensions are not allowed.

The exchange will take place during the second semester of the 2025/26 academic year and must end by September 30, 2026.

The student will specify the actual mobility period upon accepting the scholarship.

Number of available spots: 3

Financial Contribution & Payment Terms

- The scholarship is reserved for students with an ISEE (or equivalent documentation for international students) ≤ €50.000.
- Amount: €600/month, paid in two installments, the second upon completion of mobility.
- Payment is subject to funding allocation by the Ministry of University and Research (MUR).
- Only the 2025 ISEE for university study rights will be considered. Students who have already submitted it for 2025/26 tuition do not need to resubmit.
- Deadline for ISEE submission: October 30, 2025, 18:00. Late submissions accepted until November 17, 2025, 18:00 with a €100 late fee.
- International students must follow specific procedures via ER.GO and submit required documents to be eligible.
- The grant cannot be combined with other mobility scholarships for the same period and purpose from the University of Bologna.
- Recipients must repay the grant if they:
 - o Interrupt the mobility,
 - o Stay less than 3 months,
 - o Graduate before the mobility ends,
 - o Fail to pay tuition,
 - o Miss administrative deadlines,
 - o Do not obtain recognition of activities.

Selection Procedure - Italian Erasmus Program

Application Period

Applications are open from 12:00 on October 16 to 12:00 on November 4, 2025. Apply exclusively via the "Studenti Online" portal: https://studenti.unibo.it

Steps:

- Log in with university credentials
- Click "Calls"
- Select: "Bando di mobilità Erasmus italiano a.a. 2025/26 (2nd semester) Dipartimento di Chimica Giacomo Ciamician, Rimini Campus"

Required Documents

Upload the following to Studenti Online:

• Study project (signed), including title, duration, abstract with objectives and activities, host structure or research group

• Motivation letter explaining the choice of host university and project goals

Evaluation Criteria (Max 100 points)

- % of CFU earned vs. expected (max 25)
- Weighted average of exam grades (max 25)
- Alignment of study project with degree program (max 30)
- Motivation letter and coherence with student's academic path (max 20) In case of a tie, younger age prevails.

Ranking & Funding

Applications will be evaluated by a departmental committee. Rankings will be published by November 11, 2025.

If MUR funding is insufficient, a unified merit-based ranking will be created using CFU earned by November 30, 2025. Only students with a valid 2025 ISEE \leq €50.000 are eligible for funding. Others may participate without financial support.

Acceptance of the exchange and any grant must be confirmed within the specified deadlines. Withdrawals are allowed only for serious, documented reasons and require repayment of any received funds.
