Dr. Isik Neusser is an architect and educator. She holds an M.Sc. in Architecture degree from TU Wien and an MArch degree from the University of Pennsylvania. Isik has worked as an architect in New York, Vienna, and Istanbul on internationally renowned projects. She has taught design studios at UPenn and TU Wien.
