

Where? How? When? €? Who? What can I do?



ERASMUS+ 21-27, incoming/outgoing students from/to EU UNIBO is the best!



Unibo is the most attractive university at a national level for Erasmus + mobility within Europe, absorbing almost 8% of the total allocation of approximately €114 million intended for 287 financeable institutes/consortia.

Following a doubling of the funds dedicated to the Erasmus 21-27 programme, **UNIBO** obtained €9 million this year, almost doubling the allocation compared to 2021, and increasing the 2022 allocation by approximately 25%.

Submit your application via AlmaRM from 9 January 2024 to 8 February 2024 at 1pm.

How?

Do I need language certification? Check **Language requirements**

Check the language requirements at the pages 6-7 and on the attachment 1 of the call for applications, and enroll for the assessment tests within 17 January 2024, 1 pm via AlmaRM.




ERASMUS, Where?

600 universities (agreement, check on the call for applications),

- in any of the <u>26 European Union Member States</u>: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden;
- in the <u>3 countries of the European Economic Area</u>: Island, Liechtenstein and Norway;
- in the <u>accession candidate countries</u>: Turkey, the Republic of Macedonia;
- in some <u>non-EU countries participating in the Erasmus+ Programme</u>

 Partner Countries as United Kingdom and Switzerland. The mobilities towards these countries are guaranteed, but student grants will be covered by European funds equivalent to those foreseen for Programme Countries.







ERASMUS. What is the better University to go?



- Ask the professors in charge of the exchange:
 info on the web site of each professor
- One example: <u>Daniela Cavalcoli Università</u> <u>di Bologna — Accordi Erasmus+ (unibo.it)</u>
- Decide what you would like to do: THESIS, COURSES?
- Check the courses you can take at the host University and compare them with the Courses you have in your HOME University
- Try to prepare IN ADVANCE your LA (learning Agreement)



Erasmus+ mobility for traineeship



<u>Erasmus+ Mobility for Traineeships: what is it and how to apply — University of Bologna (unibo.it)</u>

Where?

In any EU countries, as in the Erasmus + study, you can go in any public sector company or a private commercial enterprise.

When?

the call for application will be published roughly on April 24,

HOW long?

The duration of traineeships under this programme is from 2 to 12 months and students may receive a *EU grant up to a maximum of 3 months*.

Who?

Students enrolled in *first, second, <u>third cycle</u>* degree programme and single-cycle degree programme, students can carry out the traineeship **before or after graduation**.

€?

From 400 to 600 € monthly depending on the destination Country + additional contribution (ISEE based)

OVERSEAS, How? When?

HOW? Each of you can apply for **3 exchanges**

You should check:

- Enrollment (from the 2° year)
- Language requirements
- Learning plan



Submit your application online through <u>AlmaRM</u> from 11 October 2023 to 14 November 2023, 1:00 p.m.

- 11/10- 14/11 application opening
- 8/01/24 score lists published, first acceptance
- 10-11/01/24 second acceptance
- You can start mobilities from July 24 (first semester 24/25, from january 25, second semester)
- July- August 2025 closing mobilities

ISEE Values (€)	Monthly

When €?

- before the mobilities (3/7 monthly rates)
- 4/7 when you came back to Bologna



Other Opportunities. Field Work

You have the opportunity to spend a mobility period for curricular internship or research for final thesis at non-governmental organisations (NGOs) or other bodies active in development cooperation (predefined or not).



What can you do?

carry out activities "in the field" in third countries where such NGOs or other entities operate.

When?

Submit your application online through AlmaRM as of 24 October 2023. <u>Deadline: 1 December</u> 2023, 1:00 p.m.

Where?

How long?

From 2 to 6 months

What can I do?

Thesis, curricular internship
