How to choose free-choice learning activities from degree programmes in Economics, Management, and Statistical Sciences (Bologna campus)

Students may take an exam only if the corresponding course has been included in their study plan.

A maximum number of places is available for students enrolled in degree programmes of the University of Bologna who wish to include courses offered by the restricted-access degree programmes in Economics, Management, and Statistical Sciences (Bologna campus).

Please check in advance with the Student Administration Office of Economics and Management whether places are still available, since **requests are accepted on a first-come**, **first-served basis**.

From your institutional email account name.surname@studio.unibo.it, send a request to segecosta@unibo.it asking for confirmation of availability. The request must indicate the exact name of the chosen course, the exam code, the number of credits, the degree programme in which the course is active, and its programme code. Example: 37293 – MICROECONOMICS (8 CFU), from the Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Finance (code 6646).

Each student may choose **a maximum of two elective courses** from degree programmes in Economics, Management, and Statistical Sciences (Bologna campus).

For the academic year 2025/26, send the request via email during the following periods:

- **7 October 7 November 2025** for courses taught in the 1st semester;
- **3 February 20 February 2026** for courses taught in the 2nd semester.

Requests sent outside these periods, or submitted by other means, will not be considered.

Maximum number of places for **Bachelor degree programmes**:

- **5 students** for each course in:
 - Economia Aziendale (CLEA)
 - Management e Marketing (CLAMM)
 - Business and Economics (CLABE) (excluding courses taught at the Buenos Aires campus)
 - Economics and Finance (CLEF)
 - Economics, Politics and Social Sciences (EPOS)
- **10 students** for each course in:
 - Economia, Mercati e Istituzioni (EMI)

For Scienze Statistiche (CLASS) and Sviluppo e cooperazione internazionale (SVIC) the Degree Programme Board's approval is required.

Maximum number of places for **Master degree programmes**:

- **5 students** for each course in:
 - Economia, Consulenza e Professioni (CLAMEP)
 - Finanza, Intermediari e Mercati (CLAMFIM)
 - Quantitative Finance (QF)
- **2 students** for each course in:
 - Direzione Aziendale (CLAMDA)
 - Health Economics and Management (EU-HEM)
 - Innovation and Organization of Culture and the Arts (GIOCA)
 - International Management (IM)
 - Economics and Econometrics (LMEC)
 - Applied Economics and Markets (LMAEM)
 - Economics and Public Policy (LMEPP)

For Statistical Sciences (CLAMSS), Greening Energy Market and Finance (GRENFIN), and Statistica, Economia e Impresa (CLAMSEI) the Degree Programme Board's approval is required.
