

Final dissertation in a foreign language

Students of the 9266 – Biomedical Engineering Master’s Degree can write their final dissertation in a foreign language other than English, to be chosen amongst the following: French, German and Spanish. The abstract always needs to be written in the language in which the Degree Programme is delivered (English).

Students of the 9243 – Ingegneria Biomedica Master’s Degree can write their final dissertation in a foreign language, to be chosen amongst the following: English, French, German and Spanish. The abstract always needs to be written in the language in which the Degree Programme is delivered (Italian).

In order to be allowed to write the final dissertation in a foreign language, students must meet one of the following conditions:

- Being enrolled in a Degree Programme whose Course Structure includes ECTS in a foreign language, in addition to the mandatory language proficiency test;
- Being enrolled in a Degree Programme partially or entirely delivered in a foreign language;
- Being enrolled in a Joint or Multiple Qualification, implemented with a foreign University;
- Having carried out the final dissertation preparation abroad or in collaboration with an international research centre;
- Having spent a mobility period abroad;

Every situation that does not fall into these cases might be evaluated directly by the Degree Programme Board.

The Biomedical Engineering Degree Programme Board, with the deliberation dated 10 July 2019, delegates to the thesis’ supervisor the ability to authorise candidates to redact their final dissertation in a foreign language, taking into consideration the content of their thesis.

The supervisor’s authorization will be granted simultaneously with the dissertation’s approval, which is given on the web application “ALMAESAMI Lauree”.

Controversial cases between the candidate and the supervisor will be forwarded to the Degree Programme Board for the resolution on the matter.
