CLAMBAS | Admission Procedures

The programme is designed with an interdisciplinary approach and an international outlook.

It includes two curricula: "Business Administration" and "Sustainable Food System Management" with a 1st common year where you can develop strong managerial skills in core business topics.

The 2nd year is focused respectively on advanced international management and sustainable food system (@Bologna campus).

The admission procedure does not change according to the curriculum. If you are admitted, you will be able to choose which one you would like to enrol in!



CLAMBAS | Admission Procedures

Restricted Access: max. **75 students** (BA + SFoodSys)

25 positions for non-EU citizens residing abroad50 positions for EU citizens and equivalent

I intake:

35 **positions** for EU citizens and equivalent

25 positions for non-EU citizens residing abroad

II intake:

15 **positions** for EU citizens and equivalent + possible residual ones



CLAMBAS | Admission Procedures

Admission requirements

- 1. Obtain your Bachelor's Degree by **December 31**st **2026**
- 2. Complete a Bachelor's Degree belonging to the course classes indicated in the call:
 - L-14 Legal Services; L-15 Tourism; L-16 Administration; L-18 Business Administration; L-20 Communication; L-25 Agriculture and Forestry; L-26 Food Sciences; L-33 Economics; L-36 Political Science and International Relations; L-GASTR Sciences, Culture and Policies of Gastronomy
- or 48 ECTS credits in the disciplinary sectors indicated in the call or applications, such as Business, Economics, Law, Mathematics-Statistics, among which 30 ECTS credits at least in the area of business.
- 3. Obtain the required minimum score in the evaluation procedure (min. 35/100)
- 4. Prove your English proficiency (B2 level)
 - NOTE! The submission of an English certification is not compulsory, but if you apply without a valid certificate, you have to pass a compulsory linguistic online test obtaining the B2 level at least.



CLAMBAS | Evaluation procedure

EVALUATION OF QUALIFICATIONS (up to 100 points – min. required 35/100) – to be confirmed

- Academic Performance according to the candidates' weighted average mark: up to 60 points
- Consistency of your academic qualifications with the degree programme: up to 15 points
- Working Experience/internship: up to 5 points
 - 0.5 points for each month of internship/work experience in the country of residence on topics related to the degree programme;
 - 1 point for each month of internship/work experience carried out abroad (outside the country of residence) on topics related to the degree programme.
- Study experience abroad: up to 10 points
- GRE/GMAT/Focus Certificate: up to 10 points (according to the score and only for candidates in the best 50th percentile)



CLAMBAS | Evaluation procedure

If your score is:

35/100 points at least: you are eligible and ranked based on your score

- > if you are **admitted** you can enrol in the programme
- ➤ If you are **eligible** you can participate in the clearing procedure for the reallocation of possible vacant positions

< 35/100: you are excluded from the admission procedure

-> Check the official call for applications 2026/27!



CLAMBAS | Deadlines

Application deadlines (to be confirmed):

- I intake (EU and non-EU): 16 April 2026
- II intake (EU citizens and equivalent only): 19 June 2026

What to do after applying (to be confirmed):

> Check the Shortlist of candidates meeting the admission requirements and of candidates who must take the English language test

I intake: 5 May 2026 II intake: 30 June 2026

➤ Take the English language test (OOPT – Online Oxford Placement Test) if necessary

I intake: 12 or 14 May 2026 **II intake:** 7 or 9 July 2026

Check the final ranking

I intake: 25 May 2026 II intake: 13 July 2026
