# Exam sessions

# Normally 3 or 4 exams are organised during the academic year. These are distributed according to the period covered by the lessons


#### **Examples:**

#### «For a 60 hour - 1° semester course»

- → 2 sessions in the Winter period (end of December mid-February)
- → 1 session in the Summer period (June July)
- → 1 session in September

#### «For a 30 hour - 1° semester course»

- → 1 session at the end of the lessons (beginning of November)
- → 1 session in the Winter period
- → 1 session in the Summer period
- → 1 session in September



# Some advice

It is always better to be fully prepared in advance than to perform poorly in exams and have to fix things retrospectively. Please:

- fill any gaps in statistical knowledge as soon as possible
- follow the study timetable, attend all of the lessons and complete all
   of the assessed work
- put your smartphones away during lessons and work hard
- take the exams in the order they are presented: first year exams first and then the second year exams
- check your UNIBO email regularly; we use it to advertise events and seminars and to advertise calls and placement opportunities
- presentations for placements and 'world of work' will be organized.



#### 1st period:

- from 7<sup>th</sup> October to 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025
- from 1<sup>st</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025 (only for those students who are completing their matriculation)

#### 2nd period (for changes):

- from 12<sup>th</sup> January to 20<sup>th</sup> February 2025
