
## **ChIR - MOBILITY SCHEME**

The ChIR is a two-year Master Programme, including one year of classes, an internship and a research project and thesis. The Master programme awards a total of 120 ECTS. The programme is articulated in two main components: the first year comprises curricular activities accounting for 66 ECTS; the second year accounts for 54 credits and includes an internship period of 15 ECTS, a research project and thesis dissertation (39 ECTS).

Student mobility is required and embedded in the program structure. Students take spend the first year in one university of the consortium (Host University). The second year must be spent in one (or two) different country(ies) of the consortium. For the second year, students are required to choose an internship and a research project from the lists provided by the Consortium. The mobility scheme is depicted below.



In the **1st year** students take the taught programme in one of the European full partner universities of the consortium (EU 1, HOST). The location of the taught programme rotates in consecutive editions.

During the **2nd year** each student completes an <u>internship</u> in an Associated Partner (AP), under a specific agreement signed with one of the full partner universities. For the <u>Research</u> <u>project and thesis</u> students move to one of the Research Host partners, EU 2 or EU 3, depending on their choice of research topic. Students may do a research project shared with EU 1 or an AP, provided a minimum of 30 ECTS of the Research year are gained in EU 2 or EU 3.
