

Guidelines to draw up the final project and carry out the dissertation in a foreign language

(Academic Senate's sessions of April 7, 2009 and February 7, 2012)

Students attending **Master's degrees** can fully draw up their final project either in English, French, German or Spanish. However, its abstract must be available in Italian.

The following categories can draw up their final project in a foreign language:

- Students enrolled on degrees having exams delivered in a foreign language, in addition to a compulsory language test
- Students who prepared their final project abroad or in collaboration with international research facilities
- Students enrolled on degrees having double or joint degrees agreement with foreign universities
- Students who spent an exchange period abroad
- Students enrolled on degrees whose teaching activities are carried out in a foreign language (in full or in part).

Those enrolled on **Bachelor degrees** – as well as master students not belonging to the aforementioned categories – can draw up their final project in a foreign language as long as their Degree Board greenlights that.
