### **Dual Degree Programmes**

- A Dual Degree is an **integrated study programme** offered upon the agreement between at least 2 universities
- The integrated study programme and the regulations for the award of the degree diploma is defined within the **agreement**
- The participation in a Dual Degree Programme implies obtaining
  2 Degrees, awarded separately after the student completes the individual requirements for each degree, legally valid in both countries



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




### **HOW DOES IT WORK:**

- 1st year: selected students complete the first 2 semester at UNIBO (60 credits for the Civil Eng. Students; 57 credits for the Environmental Eng. students)
- 2nd year: selected students attend the <u>Master of</u>
  <u>Science in Civil Engineering at UM</u>, obtain 30 US credits, 6 of which are dedicated to the Master's Thesis
- After obtaining the Master of Science Degree at UM, the credits earned will be transferred to UNIBO, where the student will defend their Master thesis and obtain the Laurea Magistrale at UNIBO.

#### 2 instalments:

- 1) 5,000 euros after acceptance and set off to the partner university

### WHO CAN APPLY: Requirements

- being enrolled in the first year of the Civil Engineering Master Programme or the Environmental Engineering Master programme – curriculum Earth Resources Engineering;
- having at least 15 credits registered in their career by 19th February 2024;
- ☐ Having a cgpa no lower than 25/30

#### HOW TO APPLY

The application can be submitted EXCLUSIVELY online **through Studenti Online (SOL)** according to the procedure indicated in the call

Deadline: February 19th at 1 p.m.

#### Compulsory documents to be enclosed:

- Bachelor Degree Certificate (or self-certification) with transcripts and final grade;
- Motivation letter in English (max one page A4), which includes the candidate's academic interests, the reasons of his/her decision to apply and the choice of a supervisor at UM (see call);
- CV/résumé with all relevant documents supporting the application;
- Trascript of records of the current degree (students can select the selfcertification which is made available on the online procedure);
- English Language Certificate (compulsory), among the following:
- IELTS Minimum 6.5
- TOEFL (Internet-based) Minimum 80
- TOEFL (Computer-based) Minimum 213
- TOEFL (Paper-based) Minimum 550

### **Dual Degree Pogrammes – ULIEGE and FHNW**

The application assessment will take into consideration:

- The motivation letter (up to 30 points)
- The curriculum of 1st level studies (up to 25 points)
- The curriculum of 2nd level studies (Laurea Magistrale): up to 25 points
- The English Language Certificate: up to 10 points
- Other experiences to be stated in the CV (i.e. study or internship abroad, publications..): up to 10 points

#### WHAT TO DO NEXT

- Acceptance of the scholarship (by email)
- Nomination: Our office will send the information related to the selected student to Miami (by March 1)

The scholarship and the mobility are subject to the acceptance by the University of Miami.

Scholarships rules (Art. 10)

**Before leaving**: having completed and registered all the activities of the 1<sup>st</sup> year

### After the mobility

- ➤ If you gain less than 30 ECTS → forfeit the double degree and the scholarship
  - The acquired credits will be acknowledged
  - o Any sum already received shall be paid back
- ➤ If you gain at least 30 credits but you do not complete all the learning activities at the partner university → forfeit the double degree but maintain the scholarship
  - The acquired credits will be acknowledged

### **Dual Degree Pogrammes – ULIEGE and FHNW**

### TUITION AND FEES

Exchange students are **not required to pay tuition fees at the host university**. They stay registered at the UNIBO and continue to pay their **tuition to UNIBO**.

However, in order to be accepted at UM, students must prove to have a certain amount of money, that is an estimate of student expenses while at the host institution.
