ERASMUS + call

• Deadline: 8/2/2024

ATTENTION NOTICE: this call for applications is conditionally issued, waiting for the European call for Erasmus+ funds and the following signature of the Erasmus+ grant agreement 2024/2025 execution between the INDIRE Erasmus+ National Agency and the University of Bologna. All the activities and the funds indicated by this call for applications are subject to change according to different rules which could be inserted in the Erasmus+ grant agreement 2024/2025. Any change will be published with a management order and communicated to all the interested students through the institutional communication channels.

ERASMUS + call 2024/2025

- Deadline: 8/2/2023
- Who can apply:
 - Students of UniBo degree and master degree programs;
 - PhD students;
- Purpose of ERASMUS+: funding a period of 3-12 months (minimum duration of 2 months in some countries) for:
 - Learning activities and related exams
 - Research activity for master/PhD thesis

ERASMUS + call: REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must be enrolled in a degree program at the University of Bologna
- The applicant must possess a certified language skill before the deadline of the call
- The languages of assessment is specified in each exchange offer https://almarm.unibo.it/almarm/welcome.html
- The test for the language assessment will be held on-line, more info here https://centri.unibo.it/cla/en/language-tests/tests-for-erasmus-study-programme
- Minimum level of A2 language skill required
- Exemption categories for language tests:

ERASMUS + call: REQUIREMENTS

Enrolment test deadline:

17/01/2023 1h pm via AlmaRM

NOTE:

A2 is the requirement from UniBo, but

- The host country may request additional language requirements
- Check details of the individual exchange opportunity required by the coordinator

In both cases the requirement may be higher than A2

ERASMUS + call: REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must **submit a study plan** to be followed at the partner University and a motivation statement. This study plan must be detailed and of course it must take into account the semester when the courses are offered vs requested mobility period.
- Students are granted the full recognition of the activities carried out abroad, **if** they were **approved in advance** by the UniBo degree program Board.
- Note that most of our coordinators at DIFA require a colloquium for the selection procedure. This means you have to show up at the colloquium.

- Login to AlmaRM to see the vacancies you are eligible for. There might be exchanges not coordinated by DIFA professors, open for your bachelor/master program
- You can apply for a **maximum of 3** different vacancies
- NOTE: the number of applications for the last call is available in the exchange vacancy general description. Take a look at the destinations that are **less requested**!

[Republic of Macedonia and Turkey]

- UK and Switzerland: In the Erasmus+ program 21-27 UK and Switzerland are partner countries, but funding are equivalent to those of Programme countries
- Non EU countries in the Erasmus+ program and relevant for DIFA (*Partner countries*) Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, South Africa (Phd only), Uruguay]

NOTE on **UK exchanges**:

- Inquire about **VISA** and health Insurance
- VISA and costs related to entrance in the UK will **not** be covered by the University of Bologna
- In most cases UK Universities ask for a specific **language certificate** before issuing letters of invitation fro VISA. Check on the University web page and directly contact them if information are required

ERASMUS + call: MOBILITY PERIOD

- This call covers a mobility period between:
 - **1/6/24 30/9/25** for Programme countries (EU) + UK + Switzerland
 - 1/6/24 31/7/25 for Partner (non EU) countries
- 2 12 months (shorter mobility 5-30 days for PhD students)

This is the only call of this year

ERASMUS + call: SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Academic progress (up to 60 pts)
 - •Student academic carrier (n of CFU, grades obtained by 15/2/24, regularity of studies)
 - •For Master students enrolled in the 1st year, the Bachelor grades are considered (6/7 of the total) and current academic carried up to 17/2/24 (1/7 of the total)
 - •For PhD students: PhD program entrance exam marks (up to 30 pts, Master final grade (up to 30 pts)

ERASMUS + call: SELECTION PROCEDURE

Evaluation by the exchange coordinator (40 pts)

- Study plan and candidate's studies
- Motivation
- Interview (if compulsory)
- language ability
- •additional elements as specified by the students in the application (additional learning experiences, specific interest etc..)

ERASMUS + call: IMPORTANT DATES

- 9 January call published
- 9 January 17 January (1h pm) Enrol for language assessment tests (AlmaRM)
- 22 January 2 February
 - Language assessment test held at te CLA.
 - Calendar will be available at https://centri.unibo.it/cla/it/test-linguistici/test-erasmus-studio
- 8 February 1 pm Deadline for application submission
- 15 February Deadline for exams registration
- 7 **March** 1st selection (list of admitted applicants available at www.unibo.it/erasmus).

 Must be accepted by 20 March
- 21 March 2nd selection Must be accepted by 22 March
- 27 March Students eligible will receive an automatic mail with the final ranked list, they have to accept the placement by 29 March
- From 29 March successful candidates names sent to partner universities

MASTER THESIS ABROAD - DIFA INTERNAL CALL

- Usually 2 calls per year (Usually in May and October)
- •Last Deadline: 20 novembre 2023
- •3-6 months mobility period
- Many applications received every year, usually the fellowship covers up to 3 months.

Erasmus+ Mobility for traineeships



• What is an Erasmus+ traineeship?

EU promoted student mobility program to fund periods abroad in any public sector company or a private commercial enterprise located in countries that have joined the Erasmus+ program

• Who can apply?

Students enrolled in a first, second, third cycle degree program. The traineeship can be **pre or post degree**

Erasmus+ Mobility for traineeships



• How long?

2-12 months, but EU grant up to a maximum of 3 months

When is the call published?

Usually in May (last call deadline 11/5/22, to start the traineeship between September 2022 and 30 July 2023)

Erasmus+ Mobility for traineeships

Hints from selection committee of the last call:

- The application:
 - Submit a complete and well-thought project, where the motivations are clear spelled out (why is it important for your academic career to spend 2-3 months at the most?);
 - Specify how the knowledge that you acquire will be verified
- **IMPORTANT:** Usually DIFA is granted 4/5 positions, but often all eligible students get the fellowship because other funding become available. You are all encouraged to apply!
