**FELLOWSHIP "Experimental Auctions"**  
**A.Y. 2018/198**  
**Second-cycle degree in International Horticultural Science**

On the 20<sup>th</sup> of June, 2019 at the Aula Manaresi of the Department of Agricultural and Food Sciences, the Evaluation Commission formed by Francesco Spinelli, Maurizio Canavari and Antonella Samoggia meets to evaluate the applications received to the call to award 1 fellowship offered to students enrolled in the A.Y. 2018/19 of The 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle degree in International Horticultural Science. The fellowship covers the registration fee for the Summer School on Experimental Auctions that will be held in Montpellier on July 2-9, 2019.

The Awarding Criteria are defined by the Art. 3, of the call. Applications have been received from the following candidates:

- *Dugyala, Sandeep*
- *Lam, Kishore*

The candidates presented their application within the deadline and have been admitted to attend the Summer School, therefore they are eligible to obtain the fellowship.

Applications are ranked according to the following criteria:

- Up to 1 points will be assigned according to Bachelor's degree final mark;
- Up to 1 point will be assigned to students possessing an additional diploma (e.g. Master degree)
- Up to 5 points for the career in the IMaHS program (transcript of records, considering exams registered and marks)
- Up to 3 points for the motivation letter

The commission evaluates the candidates.

The ranking of applicants is therefore the following:

- 2. Dugyala, Sandeep score 5.7/10
- 3. Lam, Kishore score 4.8/10


Therefore, the fellowship is awarded to the student **Coda Riccardo Adamo**.

The amount of the fellowships is 1,500.00 € and is funded by the Department of Agricultural and Food Sciences of the University of Bologna (DISTAL-UNIBO). The fellowship will be paid by the Department to the Fondazione Alma Mater on behalf of the student.
