

Technical and practical requirements to take the OOP test

Basics

In order to complete all the procedures and take the Oxford Online Placement Test you have booked you need to meet the following basic requirements

- A good internet connection
- A desktop or laptop PC equipped with a webcam
 In case you don't have a PC with a webcam or you don't have a PC altogether, please contact us
- Be sure that your computer meets the minimum system requirements. To check these, click here: system requirements. Then, click on 'automatic system check'.
- A headphone set
- You must have completed the registration procedure at the following url and have received the university credentials: https://studenti.unibo.it/sol/welcome.htm?siteLanguage=en
- You must have activated your University of Bologna e-mail account and be able to access it: https://www.unibo.it/en/services-and-opportunities/online-services/my-email/my-email-students
- The software Zoom must be installed on your device. If the software Zoom is filtered in your country, we recommend you to use a VPN.
- Be able to provide proof of your identity (passport or ID card).

Not complying with this requirement may result in the impossibility to sit the test.

Install Zoom and join the meeting

The English test you have booked is proctored through the app Zoom.


You need to download the desktop version of Zoom, not the web app.

In order to install Zoom on your device please follow the instructions at this url: https://zoom.us/download


You need to install "Zoom Client for Meetings"

In order to access Zoom with the University of Bologna credentials, on the day of the test you have to:

- Click on the link included in the invitation e-mail sent to your University of Bologna e-mail account
- Select "Sign in with SSO"



Type "unibo" in the company domain and click the "continue" button





Sign in with your University of Bologna credentials

In case you have already registered to Zoom with your personal e-mail you need to switch your account

Take the test

The day before the test (on Friday, if you have booked the test on a Monday) you will receive an invitation to take the test to your University of Bologna e-mail account from the following mail address: www-customerservice.eltonline@oup.com.

The test is closed until the scheduled day and time and you won't be able to access it beforehand. Also, please don't try to access it beforehand since your login details will be locked if you try too many times.

Just take care of this e-mail message and don't cancel it. You will need it on the day your test is scheduled and when you will be told to use it by the supervisors who will welcome you to the Zoom Meeting.

We recommend you to read the attached guide to the test and instruct yourself about the test format.

Be informed that the scheduled time for the test refers to the Time Zone currently being used in Italy: UTC +2

Frequently asked questions

Can I take the test with a smartphone?

We strongly recommend to use a PC or Laptop. If you don't have a PC with a webcam or you don't have a PC altogether, please contact us

What is the Zoom Meeting for?

It will be used by the University staff to take attendance, administer and proctor the test.

Is joining the Zoom meeting compulsory in order to take the test?

Yes, it is. If you don't show up in the Zoom meeting the test will be invalid

I have already registered to Zoom before with my private account, can I join the meeting with that?

No, you have to switch account and join the meeting with the University of Bologna credentials

I haven't received any invite e-mail to take the test and/or to the Zoom Meeting

The invitation e-mail will be sent the day before the test (or on Friday if you have your test scheduled on a Monday)

I have activated the University of Bologna e-mail account but I still haven't received any invitation e-mail to take the test and/or to the Zoom Meeting.

The invitation e-mail will be sent the day before the test (or on Friday if you have your test scheduled on a Monday)

Please search your mailbox for mails sent from the following e-mail accounts: customerservice.eltonline@oup.com and/or customerservice.eltonline@oup.com and/or cla.bo-segreteria@unibo.it If you don't find anything please check your SPAM box
