## CALL FOR ADMISSION

## Agreement with the Johns Hopkins University - possibility of attending courses for Master's degree students of the Study Courses pertaining to the Department of Political and Social Sciences - Bologna and Forlì Offices.

All students enrolled in one of the Master's degree courses of the Department of Political and Social Sciences, Bologna and Forlì Offices, listed below, may apply to attend and take the relevant examination of the course offered by Johns Hopkins University, School of Advanced International Studies (hereinafter referred to as SAIS Europe) to cover the CFUs/ECTS freely chosen by the student (activity letter D).

Applicants, (including newly enrolled students a.y. 2023/2024 must be duly enrolled in one of the following Master's degree courses:

- Local and Global Development (LM SLEG)
- Political Administration and Organisation (LM PAO)
- International Relations Bologna Campus (LM IR)
- International and Diplomatic Sciences Forlì Campus (LM SID)
- International Politics and Economics (LM IPE).

The application for admission must be completed in accordance with the form attached (attachment nr. 1) to this notice and sent by e-mail to <u>didatticasociale.rilm@unibo.it</u> (Bologna campus) or to <u>didatticaforli.lmipe@unibo.it</u>, <u>didatticaforli.lmsid@unibo.it</u> (Forlì campus), indicating "JHU Single Courses application" in the subject

## by December 7th, 2023 at 3 pm CEST

Applicants should indicate in their application, in order of preference, up to three courses they intend to attend at JHUBC, from among those offered in Annex 2 to this notice. Applicants must attach:

a self-certification of the degree; a self-certification of the examinations already taken in the Master's degree;

-certification of the examinations already taken in the Master's degr Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna

- a curriculum vitae;

- a copy of a valid identity document;

- English language certification obtained no more than three years ago or self-certification of the native speaker status (see below);

- the application form (Annex 1).

The committee, consisting of three teachers, will select a maximum of 15 candidates. Candidates must prove their competence in English by providing the results of one of the following tests:

- TOEFL: overall score of 100 (minimum)

- IELTS: overall score of 7 (minimum)

- Cambridge: C1 minimum score of 185; or C2 Proficiency (any result).

- For native English speakers: self-certification attesting the native speaker status.

The eligibility ranking will take into consideration the following criteria:

- first cycle degree grade (taking into account the specific degree course attended);

- self-certification of exams taken, taking into account the average for the specific course attended;

- result of one of the English tests indicated in the notice of competition

- curriculum vitae;

- evaluation of qualifications.

The results will be published by **January 18th, 2024** on the Department's (SPS) website <u>http://www.dsps.unibo.it/it</u> and on the websites of the Degree Programmes.

SAIS Europe will determine access to courses on the basis of the number of students enrolled in each course, (some courses have 'limited enrolment' and priority will be given to Johns Hopkins students) making a maximum of ten places available. There are no places for international students on international mobility. Individual candidates will normally only be admitted to one course and only if the number of successful candidates is less than the number of places available, will they be able to attend further courses. Course enrolments, lectures and related examinations will take place according to the schedule attached to this notice, Annex 2.

Participants in individual courses must then follow SAIS Europe's guidelines, otherwise they will forfeit any ranking rights. Participants will be granted exemption from enrolment fees at SAIS Europe, while all consumables (books, photocopies, etc.) will be charged to them.



Once admitted, students will have to follow SAIS Europe's regulations, which provide for compulsory attendance and the passing of tests in the manner laid down by individual courses. Students who do not pass the test will not be allowed to repeat it and will have to replace the course with one of those provided for in the curriculum of their degree course. Students are advised to include in the plan, among the activities of their choice, an alternative examination to be taken only in the event of failure of the examination taken at Johns Hopkins University.

Students who are declared eligible for attendance must complete the study plan in accordance with the procedures and deadlines set by the individual Study Courses.

For the academic year 2023/2024 each course will allow the acquisition of 8 CFU. The grade obtained will be converted on the basis of the following table:
