- JHU founded in 1876 in Baltimore by philanthropist Johns Hopkins
- 27,000 full-time and part-time students in ten academic divisions
- First research university in the United States
- 29 Nobel laureates
- School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS) founded in 1943 by Paul H. Nitze and Christian Herter
- SAIS Europe founded in 1955
- Hopkins-Nanjing Center founded in 1986

MAIA

Open to students in the first year of the MA IR program

- Two Degrees: Laurea Magistrale in International Relations and the MAIA
- Choose from over 75 courses each year
- Take six courses over two semesters (including two economics courses)
- Language Learning for Professional Purposes
- Take Research Methods Class
- Academic Writing Sessions
- Write an original thesis
- Career Services
- Those admitted will need 60 CFU before they begin classes at SAIS

Language Requirements

Native English-speakers required to pass a proficiency exam in one of the modern foreign languages

Non-native English speakers must pass the English proficiency exam prior to graduation


