1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

To be admitted in the Degree Programme you need to apply to the specific intake, according to the schedule appointed in the <u>General Calendar</u> and the modalities you may find in section 2. The deadlines indicated in the call for applications are mandatory and cannot be waived in any case.

Students enrolled in a Degree Programme at the University of Bologna or at another University and students with a previous university career, must participate in the selection following the indications of this call.

Intake A is addressed to non-EU candidates living outside Italy (paragraph 2.1)

Intake B is addressed to Italian, EU and EU-assimilated candidates (paragraph 2.2)

To apply, you need to possess the specific requirements specified in Paragraph 1.1 and pass the assessment of personal preparation, which will consist in an oral test, held in English (Paragraph 3.1).

The Degree Programme is held in English. A CEFR B2 level (or higher) in English is required for the admission (see Paragraph 1.1).

All candidates intending to apply to this Degree Programme must stick to the provisions of this call.

Disabled candidates or candidates with specific learning disabilities are invited to read the <u>Attachment 1</u> to request the adaptation to the oral test.

1.1. Admission Requirements

To take part in the selection, candidates must register to the selection and fulfil the following curricular requirements, indicated on the <u>Degree Programme Teaching Regulations</u>:

c. Previous five-year degree programme system

d. Foreign Degree which can be considered equivalent to the ones for students holding an Italian Degree, according to the provisions contained in the Circolare MUR (Ministry of University and Research) for A.Y. 2024/2025, which will be published in the specific webpage <u>www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/</u>.

If you do not possess your degree by the deadline for the registration to the selection, you may apply under condition. If you are selected, you must obtain your degree before 30th December 2024.

• Have a CEFR B2 (or higher) English Language Certificate, before the deadline of the registration to each selection (see <u>General Calendar</u>).

The English Language Requirement is considered as satisfied if candidates:

hold one of the certificates listed in the specific Chart (<u>Tabella certificazioni equipollenti prova idoneità linguistica</u>) available in the University of Bologna Linguistic Centre (CLA) website <u>Idoneità linguistica – Centro Linguistico di Ateneo - CLA (unibo.it</u>) if issued from 1st January 2021.

If you sit an English Language Certificate examination (among the ones accepted) and got a B2 (or higher) level, but you still have not the certificate by the deadline of the registration to the selection, you can upload an **official document** that certifies that you have taken the test and its relative results (e.g. Statement of Results) or you'll be left out of the selection.

Nevertheless, if you are entitled with a position and eventually enrol in the Programme, you need to send your official certificate to this address <u>farbiomot.pharmabiotech@unibo.it</u> from your institutional e-mail address (<u>name.surname@studio.unibo.it</u>) **before the deadline of the enrolment** (29th October 2024), **otherwise your enrolment will no longer be valid**;

- Had a B2 English Language Test done in their previous First-Cycle Degree. This will be accepted if the B2 level (or higher) is clearly stated in the denomination of the teaching activity;
- Hold a Degree obtained in English. The document must state that the Degree Programme was held in English;
- English native speakers (i.e. English is their mother-tongue).

N. B.: the certificate must be uploaded on Studenti Online <u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u> before the deadline of the registrations to each selection (see <u>General Calendar</u>) according to the modalities specified in paragraphs 2.1 and 2.2, otherwise you'll be left out of the selection.

2.1. Non-EU Citizens living outside of Italy – Intake A

2.2. Italian, EU and EU assimilated citizens – Intake B

for graduates holding a foreign Degree: Transcript of Records (either in Italian or English), with the list of all the exams assessed in the previous Career in a foreign University, and if already obtained, the Degree.

EU assimilated citizens:

If you apply as a EU assimilated citizen and you do not hold a valid residence permit to this extent, your enolment will be rejected.

3. ASSESSMENT OF CURRICULAR REQUIREMENTS AND PERSONAL PREPARATION

At the end of the registrations for each intake, an appointed Board will evaluate applications and verify that each candidate fulfils the curricular requirements (Paragraph 1.1).

The Board will evaluate only applications submitted within the set deadlines and according to the modalities explained in section 2 for each intake.

The list of admitted/not admitted candidates will be published on Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) on the dates set in the <u>General Calendar</u> only. Results will not be published otherwise.

3.1. Oral Test

Oral tests will be held in English through *Microsoft Teams*, on a videocall.

Candidates must download the app here: <u>https://www.microsoft.com/it-it/microsoft-</u> <u>365/microsoft-</u> <u>teams/download-app</u> and register using their institutional e-mail address (<u>name.surname@studio.unibo.it</u>).

Candidates who are admitted to the oral test must connect on the date and hour indicated in the <u>General Calendar</u> using thelink shown in the list of admitted candidates uploaded on Studenti Online and switch the camera on. Candidates who will be absent at the online meeting indicated in the <u>general calendar</u> will be excluded from the selection, regardless of the reasons given.

Each candidate must be available during the entire course of the interviews and must switch the camera on for the entire duration of the test. Any impediments of a technical nature may result in the end of the interview. The Board will try to contact candidates up to three times: in case candidates do not answer, they will be considered as absent and therefore excluded. In case of technical issues, the test can be suspended and therefore candidates will be excluded. The Board will check the identity of each candidate by comparing the document uploaded on Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>): upon specific request, candidates must show their documents to the Board in order to confirm the data inserted on Studenti Online while applying. Candidates' privacy will be ensured during the identification. The test will be public.

The oral test – in English – will consist of **three questions** and it is aimed at assessing knowledge and competence in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, Biochemistry and Cell Biology, Molecular Biology, Genetics, Microbiology.

3.2 Oral Test Results

The Admission Board will evaluate all candidates – regardless of the intake – through a score up to **30** points.

If a candidate scores 18 points (or more), they pass the test.

The results of the Oral Tests will be published on Studenti Online <u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u> on the dates indicated in the <u>General Calendar</u>. Results will not be published otherwise.

4. ENROLMENT

If you are admitted to the programme you need to enrol before 29th October 2024, following the specific instructions.

- If you are enrolling for the first time, see paragraph 4.1.
- If you are transferring from another University or from another Degree Programme of the University of Bologna, see paragraph 4.2 and 4.3;
- If you are enrolling under condition, see paragraph 4.4.

If you are requesting for the recognition of previous University career(s): after enrolling and before 28th November 2024, you must follow the indications published here: <u>Shortening of the degree programme</u> — University of Bologna (unibo.it)

N.B.: according to the <u>Degree Programme Teaching Regulations</u> only units taken in English may be recognized.

Credits obtained in First Cycle Degrees cannot be recognized.

If you are applying for the recognition of exams from previous academic careers in English which do not belong to the LM-9 Class taken in other Universities, you need to hand in also the relative catalogues/programmes. Contact the <u>Student Administration Office</u> for more information.

4.1. First ever enrolment to the University of Bologna

Before **29th October 2024** you must:

 Access Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>), via SPID or with your institutional personal username and password;

- select "Registration" > "Second-cycle degree programme" > "Pharmaceutical Biotechnology", insert the requested information and upload a JPG file of your passport-size photo (beware of the consequences under art. 496 of Italian Criminal Code regarding false declarations: in such case, you are punishable by law, will be not enrolled, and will lose any right to benefits or reimbursements);
- **Pay** the first instalment or the total amount of the tuition fees. Payment modes other than those indicated on Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) will not be accepted. If you do not pay within the set deadline youare left out of the selection: **late payments will not be accepted.**
- Activate your career:
 - If you enrolled via **SPID** credentials: after paying the fee your university career will be automatically activated, unless you fall into one of the cases listed below;
 - If you enrolled via your **username and password**: check the specific info you'll find on Studenti Online.

You must activate your career and finalize your enrolment before **28th February 2025** otherwise you'll lose the right to enrol in A.Y. 2024/2025.

Once your career is activated you can access Unibo services, such as study plans submission, exams booking, Wi-Fi,online libraries: you will also receive an e-mail to print your Badge, according to the modalities that will be specified within.

In the following cases there are specific information on enrolment:

- Students with disabilities: <u>Exemptions for students with disabilities</u> <u>University of Bologna</u> (<u>unibo.it</u>). - If you are a EU-assimilated citizen with a qualification obtained in Italy, you have to send the copy of yourresidence permit to the <u>Students Administration Office</u>;
- If you are a non-EU citizen living outside of Italy: you need to <u>check the specific info</u>, access Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) starting from February 2024, select "Calls" and then "Document Upload for International Students with Foreign Qualification": also upload a copy of your residence permit or the copy of the receipt, attesting the requesthas been forwarded (in this case, your enrolment will be considered as conditional until the actual residence permit can be shown);
- If you have a foreign qualification. You must check the information available <u>here</u>, access Studenti Online(<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>) and starting from February 2024 select "Calls" and then "Document Upload for International Students with ForeignQualifications": then upload the documents related to your qualification. Afterwards, once you are in Italy, you'll need to book an appointment with the International Student Administration Office to show the hardcopy of your qualification.

4.2. Candidates transferring from other Universities

Before **29th October 2024** you must:

- Hand in your transfer request to your belonging University, according to their deadlines.
- Access Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>), via SPID or with your institutional personal username andpassword (<u>name.surname@studio.unibo.it</u>);
- select "Registration" > "Second-cycle degree programme" > "Pharmaceutical Biotechnology", insert the requested information and upload a JPG file of your passport-size photo (beware of the consequences under art. 496 of Italian Criminal Code regarding false declarations: in such case, you are punishable by law, will be not enrolled, and will lose any right to benefits or reimbursements)
- **Pay** the first instalment or the total amount of the tuition fees. Payment modes other than those indicated on Studenti Online will not be accepted. If you do not pay within the set deadline you are left out of the selection, late payments will not be accepted.

Your career at Unibo will be activated only after the recognition of your transfer by the Programme Board.

N.B.: according to the <u>Degree Programme Teaching Regulations</u> only units taken in English may be recognized.

If you are applying for the recognition of exams from previous academic careers in English which do not belong to the LM-9 Class taken in other Universities, you need to hand in also the relative catalogues/programmes. Contact the <u>Student Administration Office</u> for more information.

You must also pay the specific transfer fee. More info here: <u>Transferring to the University of Bologna (unibo.it)</u>

4.3. Candidates enrolled in another Degree Programme of the University of Bologna

If you are currently enrolled in another Degree Programme of the University of Bologna, before 29th October 2024 you must:

- Access Studenti Online (<u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>), via SPID or with your institutional personal username andpassword;
- **Pay** the first instalment or the total amount of the fees of the programme in which you are currentlyenrolled for the new academic year and be ok with your fee record;
- Fill in the specific transfer request (*passaggio di corso*) on Studenti Online <u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u> and paythe transfer fee.

You will be able to take exams in the former degree programme until you send your transfer request (*passaggio di corso*), while you will have your career on the new programme activated only after the Programme Board approves your transfer.

N.B.: according to the <u>Degree Programme Teaching Regulations</u> only units taken in English may be recognized.

4.4. Under Condition Enrolment

Candidates who enroll but still do not hold a First-Cycle Degree, they must **enroll before 29th October 2024** according to the provisions set in paragraph 4.1 and **graduate before 30th December 2024**. If they do not fulfill this requirement, their enrolment will be definitely rejected. Their career will be started only after obtaining the First- Cycle Degree.

If the qualification is awarded by the University of Bologna, the information will be automatically received. If it is awarded by another University, you need to access Studenti Online <u>www.studenti.unibo.it</u>, click on "See detail" inyour application and insert the mark you obtained by clicking on the specific button.

4.5. Fees and Study Grants

Fees are recalculated according to family income as it results from a valid ISEE that must be uploaded within specific deadlines.

IMPORTANT: if you do not upload your ISEE you will be assigned with the programme maximum amount of fees!

If you are already enrolled in another study course, before transferring or transfer or transition, please read carefully the requirements to access to the benefits, indicated in the call for applications published on <u>www.er-</u> <u>go.it</u>. The University career, after the transfer or passage to the course of destination, is assessed starting from thefirst year of enrolment at the university, regardless of the awards obtained or of the year of the course to which they will be admitted by the Degree Programme Board. This could cause you to lose the benefits.

Students with disabilities with recognised invalidity of at least 66%, and those whose disability is recognised by law 104/94 must present the related certificate to the Student Administration Office – Pharmacy, Biotechnology and Sport Science (<u>segfarbiomot@unibo.it</u>).
