

Elective Courses Available to Students from Other Degree Programmes (Academic Year 2026/2027)

A maximum number of places has been established for students enrolled in other degree programmes of the University (excluding programmes in Economics and Statistics) who wish to include in their study plan educational activities offered within the degree programmes in Economics, Management and Statistical Sciences (Bologna campus).

Please Check Availability in Advance

Students are strongly advised to promptly verify with the Economics and Management Student Administration Office whether places are still available, as enrolment is limited and requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Using the **Virtual Desks (Sportelli Virtuali)** service, students must contact the Student Administration Office of Economics, Management and Statistics to request authorization ("nulla osta") to include the chosen course in their study plan. The request must specify:

- the exact title of the selected course unit;
- the corresponding examination code;
- the number of ECTS credits (CFU);
- the degree programme in which the course is offered;
- the relevant degree programme code.

Example:

37293 – MICROECONOMICS (8 ECTS credits), Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Finance (programme code 6646).

The maximum number of educational activities that each student may choose is **two courses**.

For the Academic Year **2026/2027**, requests must be submitted exclusively during the periods in which study plans are open:

- **1 October to 7 November 2026** for courses taught during the **first semester**;
- **12 February to 19 February 2027** for courses taught during the **second semester**.

Requests submitted outside these periods or through different procedures will not be considered.

Students may sit the examination only if the corresponding course unit has been officially included in their study plan and academic record. Students must therefore contact the administration office of their home degree programme to ensure that the course unit is formally added to their study plan.

Bachelor's Degree Programmes

The maximum number of students admitted per course unit is:

5 students per course unit offered within:

- Business Administration (CLEA);
- Management and Marketing (CLAMM);
- Business and Economics (CLABE), excluding courses offered at the Buenos Aires campus;

- Economics and Finance (CLEF);
- Economics, Politics and Social Sciences (EPOS).

10 students per course unit offered within:

- Economics, Markets and Institutions (EMI).

Specific Authorization Required

For courses offered within:

- Statistical Sciences (CLASS);
- Development and International Cooperation (SVIC);

admission of requests is subject to authorization by the relevant Degree Programme Board.

Master's Degree Programmes

The maximum number of students admitted per course unit is:

5 students per course unit offered within:

- Economics, Consultancy and Professions (CLAMEP);
- Finance, Intermediaries and Markets (CLAMFIM);
- Quantitative Finance (QF).

2 students per course unit offered within:

- Business Management (CLAMDA);
- Health Economics and Management (EU-HEM);
- Innovation and Organization of Culture and the Arts (GIOCA);
- International Management (IM);
- Economics and Econometrics (LMEC);
- Applied Economics and Markets (LMAEM);
- Economics and Public Policy (LMEPP).

Specific Authorization Required

For courses offered within:

- Statistical Sciences (CLAMSS);
- Greening Energy Markets and Finance (GRENFIN);
- Statistics, Economics and Business (CLAMSEI);

admission of requests is subject to authorization by the relevant Degree Programme Board.
