International Mobility - Further opportunities

Scholarships offered by the University of Bologna to all Unibo students:

Erasmus + for Study (mainly EU countries + partners)

Call for applications published in January-February of your 1st year to leave during the 2nd year - Aim: credit transfer or thesis preparation **NOT RECOMMENDED** for S.Co.Re degree programme (difficult correspondence)

Erasmus+ mobility for traineeship (mainly EU countries + partners)

 Call for applications published in March-May of your 1st year to leave during the 2nd year for Preparation of the final thesis abroad

→ NOT RECOMMENDED for S.Co.Re degree programme

<u>unless</u> you have **already agreed** the details of your thesis project **with your chosen thesis Supervisor** (host institution included) and have informed the Degree programme Director in order to obtain a proper pre-approval of the project.

Call for applications published in March-May of your 2nd year to leave as recent graduate (or if you plan a late graduation)
→ RECOMMENDED by S.Co.Re degree programme
