Deadlines for first year students - Second Cycle Degree:

First or single instalment: 28 October 2021 (with additional late enrolment fee: 25 November 2021) Second instalment: 17 December 2021 Third instalment: 15 March 2022

Tuition fees are calculated based on the **2021 ISEE value / economic situation** <u>Be careful!</u> If you do not submit your ISEE you will have to pay the tuition fee in full

International Mobility: the opportunities offered by the Degree Programme

Internship for the Preparation of the final examination – 18 cfu

TO be completed within the study programme. It is necessary in order to prepare the final experimental thesis and it will be mentioned during the final defence:

- 1. Internal internships: conducted at University of Bologna laboratories
- 2. **External internships:** conducted at host institutions and companies, public and private, trade associations etc.

External internships can be performed in ITALY or **ABROAD**

Scholarships for the preparation of the thesis abroad:

Usually **Score** degree programme offers a certain number of <u>scholarships</u> to students enrolled into the 2nd year who intend to implement their **experimental thesis outside of Italy** \rightarrow call published at the end of the first semester of your second year to leave in the second semester/summer



International Mobility - Further opportunities

Call for applications managed by the University of Bologna:

Erasmus + for Study (mainly EU countries + partners)

Call for applications published in January-February of your 1st year to leave during the 2nd year

Aim: credit transfer or thesis preparation

NOT RECOMMENDED for S.Co.Re degree programme (difficult correspondance)

Erasmus+ mobility for traineeship (mainly EU countries + partners)

- Call for applications published in March-May of your 1st year to leave during the 2nd year for Preparation of the final thesis abroad
 PARTIALLY RECOMMENDED for S.Co.Re degree programme
- Call for applications published in March-May of your 2nd year to leave as recent graduate
