REGISTRATION PROCEDURE	A. Before filling in the application for the residence permit you must Check-in at the International Relations office in Rimini Campus;
	B. You will obtain the kit with forms and instructions from a qualified post offices (Sportello Amico):
	C. When delivering the kit to the post office with the filled modules and all required documents, you will be given an appointment at the foreign citizens' office at the competent Police station (Questura) for photographic registration. You must pay : the payment slip (bollettino postale) for the electronic residence permit €110.46 and the registered letter form for sending the kit €30.
	D. Once the residence permit is issued, you must deliver a copy to the International Relations Office of your Campus (by handing in, but also by sending via mail or e-mail). If you forget it, after 150 days from the Check-in, you won't be allowed to sit exams.

EXCHANGE STUDENTS ACCESS	-Computer -Canteen -Library
	EU students who are not permanently resident in Italy, possessing an insurance in their country of residence and
	possessing an European health card (TEAM): Such students may have recourse directly to a GP of the National Health System (or to an Emergency Department of a hospital).
	EU students who do not possess insurance cover in their country of residence (no TEAM):
	Such students must take out a specific insurance policy. After that they
HEALTH CARE	may have recourse directly to a GP of the National Health System (or to an Emergency Department of a hospital).

	If such an insurance policy is lacking, the amounts due for the health treatment will be wholly charged to the student.
	Non EU Students:
	May apply for voluntary registration with the National Health Service and with a General Practitioner, by paying an annual lump sum fee;. The policy is valid for a calendar year (expiring on 31 December); otherwise they may maintain the right to compulsory registration, where provided for by law.
	They may also take out private health insurance for the duration of the study programme, covering all risks, and have a certificate of conformity to Italian law signed by the insurance company, which does not include registration with the SSN or with a GP
