Reasons for the originality verification service

- Increasing simplicity to use (even unawarely) intellectual contents of others
- To stress the importance of the originality of the contents and of a correct use of quotations
- The objective is **not only** to reveal plagiarism, but:
 - to offer teachers a supporting instrument to verify the authenticity and integrity of final dissertations
 - to intervene in the writing process of a text (preliminary writing, drafting, revisioning, editing)
 - to increase the quality of the students' final dissertations in the framework of the process of quality assurance of the educational offer




The project phases and the selection of the software

- 2011-2013 -> start of the project and experimental phase
- 2013-2017 -> first phase of consolidation
- 2017 -2018 -> European competition for a multi-year contract
- 2018 2022 –> second phase of consolidation
 - Compilatio software
 - around 1.500 users/over 13.000 analysis done
 - simple use of the system
 - access to TesiOnline and to the web
 - integration with the UniBO applications



Verification trend in 2021




How it works


- Access to the system 24h/24h

- Analysis and evaluation of the report on behalf of the teacher


















































INDICATIONS AND ADVICE

 "..." which are immediately recognized by the software.
- It is not necessary to upload images and the bibliography.
- It is recommended to upload your file on Compilatio a few days before the deadline.
