



### You don't need the certificate if you:

- Attended a first cycle degree (BA) held in English (to indicate on the Cv and in the transcript)
- Passed a B2 level English exam in the previous study plan → to be clearly indicated in your transcript!
- You are English **native speaker** (to indicate on the CV)
- Certification of **3 months** working/studying experience in non-English and English-speaking countries (internship, exchange programme)

Applications are evaluated as follows:

Part 1) CV evaluation: Bachelor's Degree, international study and/or professional experiences,

English knowledge

+ evaluation of the reference letter (optional)



List of admitted candidates to the interview



Part 2) Interview with the Admission Committee: personal commitment, attitude and skills, experiences, thesis, internships
