The Department of Legal Studies (DSG)

LEGS LLM Programme is held by the **Department of Legal Studies (DSG) of the University of Bologna**, one of Europe's most relevant Law Schools.

It has been **ranked** as the **41st-best law school in the world (QS World University Rankings 2024)**, the 1st one in Italy, and confirmed as one of the **"Outstanding Law Schools"** by the Italian Ministry for University (2023-2027).







The LLM Programme in Legal Studies

LEGS is a **2-year** (post-grad) **Programme** forming graduates for **careers in legal advisory** requiring a **supranational perspective** (i.e., international institutions, public agencies, NGOs, corporations, and law firms).

LEGS provides robust **legal skills** focusing on a large array of **law subjects** (=> *courses, seminars, laboratories, moot courts, etc.*) along with a **multidisciplinary approach**.



LEGS' Background & Cultural Heritage

- 1) Studying law in English as a cultural and professional choice.
- 2) Openness to the world and different legal systems.
- **3)** Facing complexity, the jurist as a problem solver in a fastchanging environment (=> "transition").
- **4) Integration** between academic-professional knowledge and **soft skills**.
- 5) Studying law at the "Bologna's School of Law."





LEGS is a **master's degree** designed to:

- § **study law** with a rigorous **methodology**;
- § build up your study plan by choosing amongst several courses, seminars, and other activities;
- § offer a truly **international environment**, together with students from all over the world;
- § benefit professional experiences through a curricular internship (or final thesis-based internship) and moot courts;



All nationalities*




LEGS Students - Cohort 2024/2025

LEGS Programme Structure

First-year **(54 CFU)** Students will gain the opportunity to have a robust knowledge of **legal foundations**, go **deeper into law subjects**, or even a **mix of both**, consistently with each one's academic background.

Moreover, in the **second year (66 CFU)**, Students may choose one of the following **alternative curricula**:



LEGS Programme Structure

- § Global and Transnational Legal Culture, focusing on several legal subjects from an international, European, and transnational perspective.
- § Human Rights, Environmental, and Social Justice, studying legal consequences of social transition on human rights, environmental and social affairs.
- § Law, Economics, and Finance, studying legal subjects to practice in international business and finance.
- § Law and Digitial Transition, on relevant legal subjects concerning digital technologies and AI from a personal and societal perspective.



LEGS Figures & Admission Call

- Limited Number: 100 seats.
- About 75% of LEGS Students are international (2024-2025).
- Applicants will be selected based on the quality of their academic background (not necessarily entirely focused on the law field), skills, and motivation



LEGS Admission Requirements / 1

To be admitted to the selection procedure, it is requested:

- § a First-level Degree (Bachelor's) or an equivalent degree in Law, Law Studies, or Law Subjects (LLB);
- § or any of the following Bachelors:

L-5 (Philosophy)	L-18 (Management and Econo mic sciences)	L- 37 (Cooperation and development social sciences)
L-10 (Arts/Literature)	L-20 (Communication)	L-39 (Social services)
L-11 (Languages and modern cultures)	L-33 (Economic sciences)	L-40 (Sociology)
L- 16 (Management/Administration science s)	L-36 (Political sciences)	L-42 (History)



LEGS Admission Requirements / 2

Applicants holding an **Italian First Cycle/Bachelor's Degree** must have obtained at least **30 ECTS/CFU in legal subjects** (final exam/thesis may also be included).

Extra-ECTS related to courses whose contents are relevant to legal subjects may also be evaluated.



LEGS Admission Requirements / 3 (English Proficiency)

An English minimum B2 level is also requested, as the followings:

- TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge English Language Assessment, Trinity College London, issued no longer than FOUR years before the deadline for application;
- attended a first-cycle degree taught in English;
- passed a B2 level English test/exam in your previous degree;
- being mother tongue;
- passed two courses (exams) in English.



The Admission Procedure / 1

Step 1 (qualification): applicants will be **ranked** based on previous studies and academic background (CV), as well as on language-specific skills above the minimum requirements (C1/C2).

Step 2 (online interview): applicants admitted to the interview (held in English) will have the opportunity to share their skills and experiences (including non-academic ones), as well as motivations and study expectations.



The Admission Procedure / 2

FIRST INTAKE dates will be published in the next call. (Approx. December 2024 – February 2025)
