

Erasmus+ Study Destinations





The Erasmus+ Programme allows students to study for a period at a University (that has an agreement with UNIBO) based in one of the following Programme Countries:

- the 26 EU Member States: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, the Czech Republic, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and Hungary.
- the 3 additional countries of the European Economic Area (EEA): Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway.
- accession candidate countries: the Republic of Macedonia and Turkey.

Non-EU countries (Partner countries)

The Erasmus+ Programme allows students to study for a period at a university that has an agreement with UNIBO located in one of the following Partner Countries: Albania, Australia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Canada, Jordan, Israel, Lebanon, Russia and South Africa.

- -> health insurance







Erasmus+ Study

It is provided a grant during the mobility: the amount of funding depends on the destination country of the mobility student and the number of days actually spent abroad

- **□ EU Grant: € 250-350** per month;
- **MUR integration:** from **0 to 400 €** based on ISEE

In order to submit an application:

- Enrollment at Unibo during the a.y. of mobility;
- adequate language skills (LEGS students are exempted from English for English speaking destinations)
- students must present a **study plan** to be followed at the partner institute and a related **motivation letter** (one single file);

The application is made online through AlmaRM within the dedicated deadlines.

The award criteria are: evaluation by the exchange coordinator and Academic progress

Dedicated **Info Meeting** will be held a few weeks after the publication of the call (mid-end of January 2024).




Through the **Learning Agreement**, the Erasmus+ and Overseas programme will allow the student to get the **recognition of the activities** taken abroad,

ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP

- The programme gives students a chance to carry out a traineeship with a business, training centre, university, research centre or other organization in countries belonging to the Programme
- Countries where traineeships may be performed
 - ➤ the 26 European Union member states;
 - > the 3 countries of the European Economic Area (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway);
 - > the 3 candidate members (Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey).
- Mobility to United Kingdom and Switzerland (Partner Countries) were not eligible (call 23-24)
- The traineeship may last 2 or 3 months.
- 21 scholarship for the Department of Legal Studies (A.Y. 2023-24)
- Erasmus+ grant: 400-500 € per month + MUR integration (ISEE)
- Recognisable activities:
 - INTERNSHIP 6/12/18 CFU
 - INTERNSHIP ABROAD FOR PREPARATION OF THE FINAL EXAMINATION

OVERSEAS

- The Overseas programme is run and funded entirely by the University of Bologna and is the result of collaboration agreements signed by the University with other universities in countries outside the European Union.
 - → DSG: Dickinson College, USA UTS Sydney, AU
 - UBA Buenos Aires, AR University of Auckland, NZ, etc.
- The programme offers students the chance to take attend courses (exams) and, only for specific destinations research for dissertation purposes.
- Suitable language skills (international certificates IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) are required and also meet the other specific requirements of the partner universities
- Financial contribution, provided by University of Bologna, will be calculated on the student's ISEE: ca. from 350-850 € per month
- When: october 2023 (the call close on 14 Nov. 2023)

FINAL DISSERTATION ABROAD

- Who? Students who are about to graduate or students who have graduated already, no more than 6 months before the moment of the application
- Scholarships vary from €1,000 to €3,100; the allocation of grants is intended to allow part of the preparation or continuation of the thesis abroad.
- When? The call usually foresee 2 intakes (April and October of each a.y.)
- The admission requirements are:
 - minimum level B2 knowledge of English or another language in which the research is carried out;
 - a weighted average of the exams equal to or higher than 25/30
- Candidates who, although not successful and therefore awarded the scholarship, are found to be
 eligible in the final ranking, will still be authorised to carry out their activities abroad in the location
 and for the period indicated in the application form. The authorisation will guarantee the insurance
 coverage, and will allow the student to acquire credits related to the preparation of the final test
 abroad, provided that the administrative requirements have been met.
