## **Academic Calendar**

The academic calendar shows time windows related to lessons, exams, <u>study plan</u> and graduation, as well as religious and non-religious holidays on which teaching activities do not take place, and the Christmas and Easter activity breaks.

## Study Plan

#### 1st Semester

Students must fill out personal study plans from 24 September 2024 to 24 October 2024

## Extra Term for 1st year students

1st year students may fill/amend personal study plans: from 17 December 2024

to 19 December 2024

**2nd Semester** 

Students may fill out personal study plans from 8 January 2025 to 3 March 2025



# Course Structure Diagram for students enrolled in the a.y. 2024-2025

The first year is shared and allows a choice of several legal subjects.

The second year is divided into curricula ('Global and Transnational Legal Culture', 'Human Rights, Environmental and Social Justice', 'Law, Economics and Finance' and 'Law and Digital Transition') that allow you to customise your training in a way that is consistent with your professional goals.

Through the course structure diagram you can see the main information about the training activities: the period in which lectures are held; SSD (disciplinary-scientific area) to which the learning activity belongs; CFU.

### WHO CAN PRESENT A STUDY PLAN?


A study plan can be presented by <u>properly enrolled students who have paid their tuition</u> fees and, in the case of international students, who hold a valid residence permit.



## **How to Present Your Study Plan**

The study plan can be presented <u>via Studenti Online</u> by enrolled students who access the website using their University usernames and passwords.

- 1. Log in to Studenti Online
- 2. Click on "Study Plan"



3. You may proceed to complete your study plan
After making the desired choices, remember to click on "save" so that your study plan
can be presented correctly.
