**A Two-Week Intensive Course (6 ECTS)  
Cluj Napoca, Romania, March 5-17, 2018**

The course will address the challenge of acquiring a “unique” identity rooted in personal traits and goals as well as an identity shared with the members of significant groups in the European context.
