
University of Duisburg-Essen History

- August 1, 1972: foundation of two universities (Gesamthochschulen) in the cities Duisburg and Essen
- January 1, 2003: merger of the two universities and foundation of the University of Duisburg-Essen (UDE)
- March 12, 2007: foundation of the University Alliance Ruhr
 (UA Ruhr), a strategic research alliance with neighboring universities
- **2014:** UDE is again among the 20 best of the young universities in the world (Source: THE-100 rankings under 50)




