





How we understand history relates to how we conceptualise time: From notions of circular time in classical antiquity, through Christian eschatological visions of an end to human time, to modern scientific concepts of absolute time derived from Newtonian physics. Time may be conceptualised as a measure of movement, as change, as subjective or objective, as singular and linear or multiple and complex. It may be understood as a container for historical events, or, on the contrary, as something given by and through these events. The time of history may be experienced as accelerating, repeating itself, or coming to a halt. With this conference, we wish to invite a discussion on time, history, and related matters: how are they imagined through concepts and metaphors, from ancient Greek and Roman times to the present day, and how are they represented in texts, images, and art?
