Chaos (and) order in the Garden

1. What kind of soil is it?

The soil is clay and volcanic, is located in the southeast, and receives sunlight from sunrise to sunset.

2. Are the plants planted in the ground or in pots?

The plants are planted in the ground with a few exceptions that remain in pots.

3. Is the irrigation system to be considered among the materials?

is not to be considered among the materials: peat, gravel around the garden, irrigation system. Irrigation system is to be considered within materials when it is a special and uncommon system.

4. My project involves special lighting, do I have to include it in the material costs?

Yes, in the case of artistic lighting, it will be necessary to include it within the material costs. It must therefore be implemented. No, in case it is standard lighting.

5. Is the budget of 10,000 € to be considered including VAT?

Yes, the budget is vat included.



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6. The budget is 5,000 € in plants and 5,000 € in materials, is it possible to make 6,000 € and 4,000 €?

It is possible to increase the budget related to plants e.g. 6,000 € in plants and 4,000 € in materials, it is not possible the other way around.

7. I went over the budget for materials, can I still participate?

You can still participate in the call by covering the cost of extra materials through external sponsors directly involved by you. In this case, the Radicepura Team will make sure to give visibility to the sponsor in the communication related to the garden.

8. How should I rename the project files?

The judges will review the various applications anonymously, so only the project name should be in file A, file B the project name plus designer or team name. All project pages should be numbered with the project title on each page.

9. Can I submit the project in 1/50 scale?

The announcement requires a "minimum 1/25 scale" but we accept up to 1/50.

10. What size or shape should the garden be?

In the first phase we do not require a specific size or shape but a design that, for those who pass the initial phase, must be placed in a predefined space chosen by the jury. Gardens in past editions had a maximum size of 50 square meters. 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11. Does the whole team have to sign up for the call?

No only one member, the team leader, needs to be enrolled, however it is convenient for all members to sign up to stay updated and receive our emails.

12. In what language should I submit the project?

In English, and if you can also in Italian.

13. How long will the gardens be visitable?

The gardens will be visitable in Radicepura from April until November 2025.

14. Who will create the gardens?

It is crucial for us that the landscapers come by presence to make the garden, each garden will be allocated about a week's time from March to the end of April.
