ERASMUS + call 2022/2023

- Deadline: 10/2/2022

ATTENTION NOTICE: this call for applications is conditionally issued, waiting for the European call for Erasmus+ funds and the following signature of the Erasmus+ grant agreement 2022/2023 execution between the INDIRE Erasmus+ National Agency and the University of Bologna. All the activities and the funds indicated by this call for applications are subject to change according to different rules which could be inserted in the Erasmus+ grant agreement 2022/2023. Any change will be published with a management order and communicated to all the interested students through the institutional communication channels.



ERASMUS + call 2022/2023

- Deadline: 10/2/2022
- Who can apply:
 - Students of UniBo degree and master degree programs;
 - PhD students;
- Purpose of ERASMUS+: funding a period of 3-12 months (minimum duration of 2 months in some countries) for:
 - learning activities and related exams
 - Research activity for master/PhD thesis



ERASMUS + call 2022/2023: REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must possess a certified language skill before the deadline of the call
- The languages of assessment is specified in each exchange offer

Enrolment test deadline:
18/01/2022 via AlmaRM

NOTE: There are special cases where students already have the certification, check the call!

NOTE: the host country may request additional language requirements. Check details and/or contact the exchange coordinator

ERASMUS + call 2022/2023: DESTINATIONS

- Universities that have an agreement with UniBo
 - Also open to countries outside EU (*Partner countries*)
 - Eu countries (*Program countries*)
 - UK and Switzerland are from this call *Partner Countries* but the grant will be as for Program countries

Students are granted the full recognition of the activities carried out abroad, if they were approved in advance by the UniBo degree program Board

NOTE: Some change request a **compulsory** interview with the exchange coordinator



ERASMUS + call 2022/2023: DESTINATIONS

- This call covers a mobility period between:
 - 1/6/22 - 30/9/23 for Programme countries (EU) + UK + Switzerland
 - 1/6/22 - 31/7/23 for Partner (non EU) countries
- This is the only call of this year
- Candidates can submit 3 applications max (online through AlmaRM)



ERASMUS + call 2022/2023: MOBILITY PERIOD

- This call covers a mobility period between:
 - 1/6/22 - 30/9/23 for Programme countries (EU) + UK + Switzerland
 - 1/6/22 - 31/7/23 for Partner (non EU) countries



ERASMUS + call 2022/2023: IMPORTANT DATES

- 11 January call published
- **11 January - 18 January (12h)** Enrol for language assessment tests (AlmaRM)

- **24 January - 4 February**
 - Language assessment test held at te CLA.
 - Calendar will be available at <https://bandi.unibo.it/s/diri/bando-erasmus-studio-2022-23>
- **10 February 1 pm** Deadline for application submission
- 1 March 1st selection (list of admitted applicants available at www.unibo.it/erasmus) Must be accepted by 16 March
- 17 March 2nd selection — Must be accepted by 23 March
- 24 March Students eligible will receive an automatic mail with the final ranked list, they have to accept the placement by 30 March
- From 31 March - successful candidates names sent to partner universities

- **What is an Erasmus+ traineeship?**

EU promoted student mobility program to fund periods abroad in any public sector company or a private commercial enterprise located in countries that have joined the Erasmus+ program

- **Who can apply?**

Students enrolled in a first, second, third cycle degree program. The traineeship can be **pre or post degree**

Erasmus+ Mobility for traineeships

- **How long?**

2-12 months, but EU grant up to a maximum of 3 months

- **When is the call published?**

Usually in May (last call deadline 12/5/21, to start the traineeship between September 2021 and 30 July 2022)

- **What is it?**

Program for student mobility outside EU, in partner Universities that have a collaboration agreement with UniBo

- **When is the call published?**

Usually in October (last call deadline 15/11/21, to start the overseas in the AA 2022/2023).

- **How long?**

1 semester - 1 academic year

- **Who can apply?**

Students enrolled at least in the second year of a first cycle or second cycle degree program.

At the time of application, candidates must already have obtained the level of language proficiency required by the universities they want to apply for.
