Depositing dissertations in digital form

Collecting dissertations and managing the bibliographies thereof; on-line access and perusal of second-cycle and single-cycle degree dissertations, including the old system.

The School of Engineering and Architecture and the **G.P.Dore** Engineering Library adopt the **AMS Tesi di Laurea** service created by Alma-DL from the Departmental and Documental Systems Area.

The service draws on a University Institutional Depository of single-cycle and second-cycle degree dissertations (including those from the old system) to form a collection (complete with bibliographic management) which may be accessed and read on line.

The project aims to enhance the bibliographic services that handle degree dissertations, boosting the impact and visibility of these last inside and outside the University via advanced information retrieval services.

Those graduating from second-cycle, single-cycle and former-system degree programmes are urged to archive a copy of their manuscript in electronic format (.pdf) at the AMS Tesi di Laurea Depository, and register a signed and printed declaration of having done so at the Dore Library before sitting their final examination.
