

Exam sessions

There are 3 exam sessions for each course for each academic year + a fourth examination date. The exam sessions are defined as it follows:

- ⇒ **October/November** (mid-term exam session at the end of the 1st period of lessons of the 1st semester)
- ⇒ **January/February** (exam session at the end of the 2nd period of lessons of the 1st semester)
- ⇒ **April** (mid-term exam session at the end of the 1st period of lessons of the 2nd semester)
- ⇒ **June/July** (exam session at the end of the 2nd period of lessons of the 2nd semester)
- ⇒ **September** (third exam session).

> **For courses of 40 hours or more**, it is possible for students to take a mid-term partial exam at the end of the 1st period of lectures. At the end of the 1st period of lectures students can take:

- **A Mid-term final exam** if lessons have already finished
- **A Mid-term partial exam** if lessons continue in the 2nd part of the semester.

1st semester courses - exams are scheduled as it follows:

- **October/November:** 1st partial exam
- **January/February:** 2nd partial exams and 1st final exam session in the same date
- **January/February:** 2nd final exam session
- **September:** 3rd final exam session

2nd semester courses - exams are organized as follows:

- **April:** mid-term partial exams
- **June/July:** 2nd mid-term exam and 1st final exam session on the same date
- **June/July:** 2nd final exam session
- **September:** 3rd final exam session

The mark obtained in the 1st partial exam can be preserved until the 2nd partial exam is successfully passed in the same academic year.

Exam dates are scheduled to respect the minimum number of days established for the courses taught in the semester previous to the exam session.

Fourth examination

Normally, the fourth examination date is set during the following sessions:

- at the end of the winter examination session for the subjects of the previous semester (summer session)
- at the end of the summer examination session for the subjects of the previous semester (winter session)

All students can submit a request within the deadlines published on the degree programme website (approximately beginning of December/Middle May), sending an e-mail by their institutional account to ems.fo.appelli@unibo.it with the following email subject: IV examination date + name of the course unit. In the email body students must indicate their matriculation number, Degree Programme and curriculum.

Preservation of single disciplines marks (for integrated courses - I.C.)

The exam marks of each single disciplines (if successfully passed) can be preserved until February 2019. By this deadline, if students fail to pass the remaining exam, they will have to take the whole integrated exam again.
