

4.2 Curricular requirements

In order to be admitted to the Second Cycle Degree Programme in Resource Economics and Sustainable Development applicants must hold a first-cycle academic qualification:

- ex Italian Ministerial Decree no. 270/04:

L-18 Business administration

L-33 Economics

L-36 Political sciences and international relations

L-41 Statistics

- ex Italian Ministerial Decree no. 509/99:

class 15 Political sciences and international relations

class 17 Business administration

class 28 Economics

class 37 Statistics

or

- Previous four-year degree programme system: qualification from a Faculty of Economics or a qualification with equivalent legal value

or

- Three-year university degree: University Diploma from a Faculty of Economics or equivalent diploma with the same legal value.

Otherwise

- hold a first cycle degree in any degree class other than the above-mentioned and have achieved 36 university credits in the following disciplinary and scientific fields:

- Area 01 - Mathematics and informatics: from MAT/01 to MAT/09, INF/01 informatics
- Area 03 – Chemistry: from CHIM/01 to CHIM/12
- Area 05 – Biology: from BIO/01 to BIO/19
- Area 08 – Civil engineering and architecture: from ICAR/01 to ICAR/12, from ICAR/14 to ICAR/16, from ICAR/20 to ICAR/22,
- Area 09 – Industrial and information engineering: ING-IND/09
- Area 12 - Law: from IUS/01 to IUS/10, from IUS/12 to IUS/17, IUS/21
- Area 13 - Economics and statistics: from SECS-P/01 to SECS-P/13, from SECS-S/01 to SECS-S/06
- Area 14 - Political sciences: from SPS/04 to SPS/14

20 out of which in the following disciplinary and scientific fields:

- Area 01 - Mathematics and informatics: from MAT/01 to MAT/09, INF/01 informatics
- Area 12 - Law: from IUS/01 to IUS/10, from IUS/12 to IUS/17, IUS/21
- Area 13 - Economics and statistics: from SECS-P/01 to SECS-P/13, from SECS-S/01 to SECS-S/06
- Area 14 - Political sciences: from SPS/04 to SPS/14

In case of a qualification obtained abroad and recognised as suitable, the verification of the aforementioned curricular requirements will be carried out by a Commission appointed by the Degree Board.
