Mazzotti Anatomy Conferences (MACs)

(MACs) began in 2010 earning international recognition and praise. Named for the President of the Bologna Medical School and of the European Federation for Experimental Morphology, the late Professor Giovanni Mazzotti hoped to invite students from a variety of universities. Each year, hundreds of students apply and over 1000 have participated in our programs.

In addition to many hours in the laboratory, the participants learn about American medical professions, education, and health care. Pre- and post-conference exams are used to assess the effect dissection has on their knowledge of anatomy.

Accommodations and Meals

Accommodations are included in conference fees. You will be sharing a room with 4-10 other medical students. Each participant may choose one roommate, the others will be assigned based on registration survey results. Little time will be allotted for sleeping.

The participants will stay at The Charter Place with 3-5 bunk beds per room, nice shower facilities, and lounging areas inside and out. There is a large video screen, musical instruments, basketball, pingpong and Karaoke. Most meals are included unless there is an offsite activity or free time. It is near a large park for running, golf, tennis, a zoo, restaurants.





Application

Applicants will begin the registration process upon their university and Chartered Professors approval. Tutors in Italy and administrators in Buffalo will assist with conference coordination. Airfare should not be purchased until the deposit is accepted. All students are required to obtain health insurance and we suggest travel insurance.
