

Between 1987 to today the Erasmus program allowed millions eruropean students to study in a foreign country or carry out an internship or the thesis preparation in an European Union country

Almost double funding for the **new 2021-2027 program** compared to the previous one (2014-2020) with the aim of involving another 10 million students

This program allows to perform a mobility from 3 to 12 months.



Some important points to remember

- ✓ The call for application will be published on January
- ✓ The call will close on February
- ✓ Departure from the **NEXT** academic year; it is important to **plan** ahead
- ✓ Application for three destinations
- ✓ All students are required to sit a language test and achieve at least the A2 level unless they are enrolled in degree programmes taught entirely in English. A certified higher language level will result in a better ranking score.

NB: check the specific language requirements of the exchange and the validity of the language certificate







Erasmus+ Study



- The program allows you to carry out mobility period from 3 to 12 months
- Student has to be regularly enrolled in a study program at UniBO in order to attend courses, sit exams, perform the internship and/or prepare the theses at the University Partner and earn credits once they return to Bologna
 - Attention! Starting from the academic year 2025/26, Wageningen University will no longer allow thesis preparation and/or internships within the **Erasmus+ Study** programme
- Financial contribution: monthly amount based on the destination country + possible additional support based on ISEE + possible contribution for green travel With the status of Erasmus+ student, you don't have to pay any enrollment fees at the Partner University
- United Kingdom and Switzerland (there might be exceptions and restrictions) + other non-EU countries (partner countries) are included
- NB: about one week after the publication of the call, an information session in Italian will be held via Teams with detailed instructions on how to apply; slides will be available in English at the end of the meeting

The assessment tests will be held in person from 18 November 2025 to 21 November 2025.



Erasmus+ Mobility for traineeships is the EU-promoted student mobility programme which gives students a chance to broaden their

vocational and training curriculum by working abroad in any public sector company or a private commercial enterprise located in European countries that have joined the Erasmus+ Programme. The Erasmus+ Mobility for traineeships Call for applications is published every year by the University of Bologna.

Erasmus+ Mobility for Traineeship



- The program offers the opportunity to carry out a traineeship mobility (Curricular Internship OR Internship
 Abroad For Preparation Of The Final Examination) in any public or private organization active in the labor
 market or in the fields of education (es. Universities)
- Duration: minimum 2 month, maximum 6 month (consecutive period)
- The Call opens in March and the deadline is in May
- The mobility will start from September of the academic year following the one in which the call was published and must be concluded by September 30 of the subsequent year.
- Students must be regularly enrolled at and can carry out the traineeship before or after graduation Recent graduates can participate but you must be an UniBO student by the deadline of the Call and performing the mobility within 12 months after graduation
- NB: about one week after the publication of the call, an information session in Italian will be held via Teams with detailed instructions on how to apply; slides will be available in English at the end of the meeting

Erasmus+ Mobility for Traineeship



- ✓ The student must fulfill a certain linguistic requirement specified in the Call that is equal to level B1, a higher certified language level will result in a better ranking score. (NB: please check the specific language requirements for each exchange and the validity of the certification)
- ✓ Financial contribution: monthly and based on the country of destination + possible ISEE integration + possible contribution for green travel
- ✓ Candidates must find the host organisation independently and formulate the traineeship programme with said organisation, agreeing on the content of the internship training project (acceptance by the host institution must be formalized by completing and signing a specific form to be uploaded into AlmaRM at the time of application)
- ✓ Selection Criteria: traineeship project content and its relevance to the candidate's study, language proficiency, motivational letter and profit
- ✓ Each candidate may submit ONLY ONE application.

Italian Erasmus



- For the a.y. 2025/26, within the framework of the MUR "Italian Erasmus" Programme, agreements have been established between DISTAL and:
 - University of Milan
 - University of Padua
- Selected students will be able to carry out a mobility period of 3–6 months aimed at curricular activities or thesis preparation.
- Winners will be selected based on merit and income criteria and will receive a monthly scholarship – the amount will be specified in the call for applications.
- The Italian Erasmus Call is open to outgoing UniBO students who will be able to undertake the mobility during the <u>second semester</u>.

Blended Intensive Program – Erasmus BIP



- BIPs are short-term (5-30gg) intensive study programs, which include:
 - in-person attendance (courses, educational visits, other activities organized by the host organization)
 - online attendance (research, data analysis, group work)
- The students that will successfully complete the programme will receive CFU, which
 will be recognised by the Study Course as Type D activities (optional courses in the
 study plan) for a specific SSD Subject Group (es: 4CFU in AGR/04).
- Selected students will receive a financial contribution to cover expenses related to the physical mobility, and may also benefit from the Green Travel contribution.
- Those Calls are open to specific degree programme and there are few scholarship available for each call places

Who can participate?

Who is regularly enrolled at the University of Bologna at least for the second year of a first-level degree course or the first year of the master's degree and at the same time has adequate linguistic skills and specific requirements required by the universities partner.

Are there any language requirements?

Yes, it is necessary to possess the language requirements and certifications required by the partner university. For details relating to each university, it is recommended to consult the call for applications and the sheets relating to the individual sites.

How long is an Overseas exchange?

You can perform the mobility for a semester or an academic year, the exact duration of the exchange period depends on the academic calendar of the partner institutions: the minimum period to receive the contribution for just a semester is 3 months while minimum period to receive the contribution for the whole academic year is 8 months.

Thesis Abroad Call

The call for scholarships for thesis abroad is aimed at stimulating the preparation of degree theses at universities and other foreign institutions.

The scholarships are intended as <u>partial</u> <u>financial</u> <u>support</u> for expenses related to the winner's stay.

Duration: from 2 to 6 months

 The Call is published 2 times a year (only for DISTAL Bologna and Imola students and usually in February/March e June/July)

It is important to remember that the scholarships for theses abroad are <u>incompatible</u> with contributions made in other study programs concerning the <u>same period</u> of stay and for the <u>same</u>

purpose!

No double funding is allowed!

Thesis Abroad Call



The "Thesis Abroad" Call is **NOT** part of the Erasmus+ Programme; applications must be submitted via **Studenti Online**.

Eligible students:

- 2nd and 3rd year students of Frist cycle/Bachelor's degree programmes
- 1st and 2nd year students of Second cycle/Master's degree programmes
- Students who are **one year** past the regular duration of any Degree programme ("fuori corso")

Attention!! The call requires several attachments to be uploaded in PDF format. Please make sure to complete and upload them correctly, following the instructions provided in the call text.

Important reminder:

- Mobility period: The mobility dates indicated must be accurate when applying. If you are selected and need to modify the declared dates, you must promptly inform the relevant offices of any changes, and BEFORE the declared start date
- The Thesis Project can make a difference! It is one of the key elements evaluated by the committee for the final ranking.

TNE Call – Transnational Education

PREPARE YOUR THE SIS ABROAD!

The international mobility Call TNE – Transnational Education for extra-UE mobility, offers the opportunity to carry out the preparation of your thesis or research activity.

The call is open to Master's degree students (Second cycle degree students) only, and offers mobility opportunities with partner institutions in:

- East Africa (project Afya Moja and project Wagon2Africa)
- Middle East e North Africa (project MARE)
- Argentina (project Moving Italianness)

The programme provides mobility grants for periods of at least two months, including also the coverage of return travel expenses.

The mobility period must be completed no later than 1 March 2026 (non-negotiable deadline).

Applications must be submitted via Studenti Online attaching the following documents: thesis/research project, declaration by your supervisor, letter the host university. All attachments will be **evaluated** and contribute to the final ranking.

The calls offer **3** application windows (NB: please check the website for exact dates):

- June July
- September October
- November



Final Reminders...

- Plan the application to the Call and your mobility period in advance
- Knowledge of a foreign language
- There is always a scholarship
- ❖ You can extend your mobility period only for Erasmus+ Study and Mobility for Traineeship Calls
- ❖ Even if you have already applied for one of these calls, you can participate in others; you can be selected for multiple calls provided that the mobility periods are consecutive and have different purposes: no double funding allowed
- ❖ If you are a winner of one of those Calls but you withdraw later on, you can apply for the next Call the following year
- Activities carried out abroad are always recognized by UniBO (make sure to correctly submit all documentation on AlmaRM within the deadlines)
- If you earn CFU abroad (exams, SSD, internship, thesis), the graduation committee awards a bonus on your final grade
- ❖ You do not have to pay any enrollment fees at the host University (exceptions: Overseas)
- Green Travel: contribution in case of ecological travel, granted only for Erasmus+ Study and
