PRELIMINARY MEDICAL CHECK TO ATTEND CLINICAL CLERKSHIPS Year 2 students of the MEDICINA E CHIRURGIA Degree Programme, Bologna Campus Year 1 students of the MEDICINE AND SURGERY Degree Programme

Pursuant to Legislative Decree 81/2008 about occupational health and safety, the University of Bologna and the S.Orsola-Malpighi teaching hospital agreed on the following procedures.

Year 2 students of the Medicina e Chirurgia Degree Programme (Bologna Campus) and Year 1 students of the Medicine and Surgery Degree Programme must undergo a preliminary medical check at the Occupational Medicine Unit headed by Prof. Violante at the S.Orsola-Malpighi teaching hospital.

At the 1° APPOINTMENT a blood test will be carried out:

- A complete blood count and basic metabolic panel.
- To detect laboratory evidence of immunity against airborne infectious diseases (measles IgG, rubella IgG, mumps IgG, chickenpox (varicella) IgG) and bloodborne transmissible diseases (hepatitis B surface antibody HBsAb, hepatitis C antibody).
- IGRA test (QuantiFERON) for tuberculosis.

Please fast before your blood test appointment. If your appointment is later in the morning, a light breakfast of tea, fresh fruit, rusk; please eat at least three hours before your blood test.

At the 2° **APPOINTMENT**, the student will undergo a **medical examination**. The Occupational Medicine doctor will **assess the blood test results and the immunization status of the student** to **issue the eligibility certificate** required to book clinical clerkships. Vaccination will be offered, when appropriate, according with scientific recommendations.

BOOKING PROCEDURE

Available from May **12th**, **2025** (deadline June 10th, 2025, or earlier if all available places are filled) the dedicated **call center** will accept bookings for the **1° APPOINTMENT** (blood test).

Students must dial +39 051 4206223, press key 3, and tell the operator the code UNIBO SOMM. The call center answers Mondays to Fridays, from 08:15 to 18:00.

On the day of the first appointment (blood test) the student will receive from the Occupational Medicine Unit the **2° APPOINTMENT** for occupational health medical examination.

ON THE DAY OF THE FIRST APPOINTMENT AND ON THE DAY OF THE MEDICAL EXAMINATION the student must arrive at the scheduled time **and bring the following documents:**

- 1. Health insurance card
- 2. University badge
- 3. Vaccination certificate, (or immunization record) providing a history of all the vaccines received as a child and adult, also in printout copy (the certificate can be retrieved from the Fascicolo Sanitario Elettronico and, for residents of Bologna and its Province, also at Public Hygiene clinics of the Azienda USL of Bologna, otherwise it is necessary to enquire for this document at the Municipality or Ausl of residence).

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: For those who have a vaccination certificate in a language other than Italian, it is necessary to present a copy of the document translated into Italian or English on the day of the visit).

RESCHEDULING APPOINTMENTS

Any change or cancellation of 1° appointment (blood test) must be promptly notified (no later than the day before the scheduled appointment date) at +39 051 4206223 (don't write to Unibo office).

Students who have already undergone the blood test and are unable to attend the **2° appointment** must cancel and reschedule the **medical examination** by e-mail <u>appuntamenti.medicinalavoro@aosp.bo.it</u>.

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
