Number of students for round: 10

Type of registration: for out-of-course and Erasmus students directly with email communication to the responsible teacher.

Annual period:

- from January to December, with suspension in July and August.
- Monthly shifts associated with the communicable disease CCT

Organization of the activity:

- Presentation of the CCT, its organization and presentation of activities of the training.
- Two mornings in the dissecting room, with small and large animals for necropsy examinations.
 Independent execution of necropsy and production of appropriate diagnostic hypotheses (reporting)
- Five half days dedicated to the vision of cytological and histological preparations and of organs
 with macroscopic lesions, of pre-selected cases including different types of preparations,
 correction of necropsy reports, discussion of histological / cytological cases, collective vision of
 preparations received at the diagnostic service.
