Organization

Core Clinical Training (CCT) in Pathology - Organization

Timetable: the day, time and place of the initial meeting will be sent by e-mail, a few days before the month of registration, with all the necessary information, by the CCT contact person. The trainee is required to report on the first day of the placement.

Maximum number of students for round: 9

Type of registration: on the lists in SOL. For off-campus students, please email the traineeship service (tirocinio.vet@unibo.it) and in CC. the traineeship delegate (a.balboni@unibo.it) specifying the CCT and the month-quarter of interest. For Erasmus students directly to the lecturer responsible by e-mail.

Annual period:

- Seven and a half months (15 fortnightly rounds) from January to December with suspension in July, August, October and November.
- Monthly shifts associated with the transmissible disease CCT (in principle with the exception of December in the second fortnight of the month)

Attendance:

- Compulsory attendance at 80% of planned activities.

Organization of the activities:

- Presentation of the facility, its organization and presentation of activities of the training. Visit to the laboratories. Safety procedures
- Four mornings in the dissecting room, with small and large animals for necropsy examinations. Independent execution of necropsy and production of appropriate diagnostic hypotheses (reporting)
- A morning outing at the IZS in Bologna (via Pietro Fiorini 6), the date and arrangements for which will be announced at the initial meeting.
- Five half days dedicated to the vision of cytological and histological preparations and of organs with macroscopic lesions, of pre-selected cases including different types of preparations, correction of necropsy reports, discussion of histological / cytological cases, collective vision of preparations received at the diagnostic service, collection, preparation and staging of histological preparations, collection and staging of samples for cytological examination.

Organization

Assessment and recording:

- The assessment will be carried out daily at the end of the activity through the verification of the acquisition of skills
- The acquired eligibility is recorded after agreement with the teacher in charge for recording the module (Prof. Barbara Bacci)
