

## Syllabus

**Teaching course: “Veterinary Legal Medicine, Veterinary Legislation and Animal Protection” (3 CFU; 27 hours: 24 hours of academic lessons and 3 hours of practical lessons)**

**Learning objectives:**

1) to allow the student to work in compliance with the health care law currently in force, in public and private practice as well as in livestock industry; this teaching course also provides the necessary knowledge to attend the 5<sup>th</sup> year’s professional practical training on transmissible diseases and cross-compliance.

2) to provide the student with the necessary knowledge and working method to autonomously identify and critically analyse the law currently in force and relevant to the veterinary profession at any level (international, European, national and regional); in this perspective, the program contents regarding the fundamentals of law and the special part topics will be propaedeutic for reaching this objective.
